Actions:

The committee approved several changes to existing graduate programs in the College of Education and the College of Business. Such changes were necessary to either improve student experience and success rates, or to align existing programs with state law (in the case of education programs).

The committee approved a new Certificate Program in Leadership Management for the College of Business.

The committee approved a new Educational Leadership Program track for master students in the College of Education.

The committee approved Dept. of Journalism's proposal for a new master's program in Digital Journalism and Design, offered as an online distance-learning program.

The committee approved several new graduate courses for the College of Education and one for the Dept. of Psychology.

The committee reviewed and approved changes to the 2011 Graduate Catalog.
