It is my pleasure to announce that Dr. William Hogarth will serve USF St. Petersburg as interim regional chancellor of the University of South Florida St. Petersburg and Frank A. Biafara, dean of the USFSP College of Arts and Sciences, will lead the search committee for a new regional chancellor.

As many of you know, Dr. Hogarth is currently director of the Florida Institute of
