Due to the closing of the University on Jan. 2, our New Student Orientation schedule has been revised -

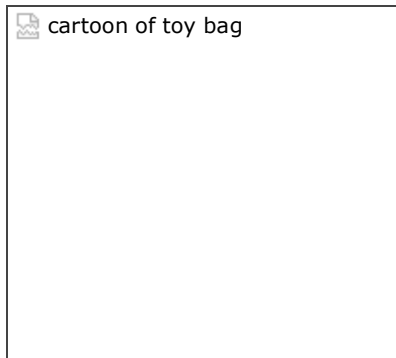
New Student Orientation sessions will be offered as follows:
