Why Open Access in Education?

Closing the research-practice divide

- 2008 NIH and other governmental mandates
 - All results of federally-funded work must be available to the public



The Desire of Faculty to Develop New Models of Scholarship

- A reaction to traditional models of control & restricted access to information
- Technology that enables users to do things they couldn't before
 - Collaboration
 - Free flow of information
 - Supports distributed scholarship

Accommodating research that doesn't fit into traditional models


New Models of Scholarship


