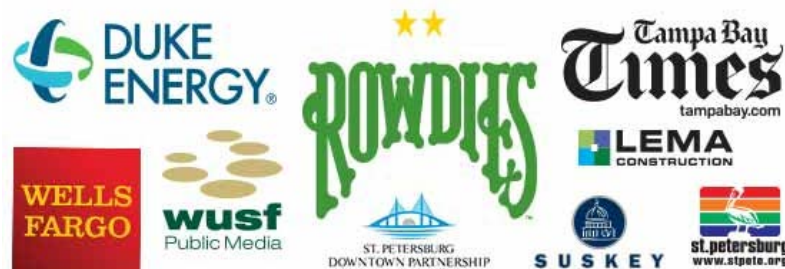
The final **USFSP By the Decades** event celebrated the University's 50 years with former students, staff and faculty from every era. The event included images and artifacts from throughout the institution's history.
