Grant Opportunities

Performance Work Embodying Spirit of Exploration

Administered by Creative Capital with support from the Doris Duke Charitable Foundation and the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, the Multi-Arts Production Fund was founded on the principle that experimentation drives human progress, no less in art than in science or medicine. The fund has announced a call for Letters of Inquiry from artists, ensembles, producers, and arts presenters whose work in the disciplines of contemporary performance embodies this spirit of exploration and inquiry.

The fund is particularly interested in supporting work that examines notions of cultural difference or "the other," be it in class, gender, generation, race, religion, sexual orientation, or other aspects of diversity. Only projects that contain a live performance will be considered. Up to forty grants ranging from \$10,000 to \$45,000 will be awarded in 2013 to nonprofit arts organizations.

Deadline for Letters of Inquiry is Oct. 4, 2013
