USFSP to Celebrate Relationship with City of St. Petersburg

USF St. Petersburg students will participate in "USFSP Day at City Hall" on Thursday, April 14 from 8:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Students will interact with city leaders and learn about what goes on behind-the-scenes to make St. Petersburg such a great city.

This is not the first time, though, that USFSP and the city have celebrated their mutual appreciation. In previous years, USF St. Petersburg students celebrated City of St. Petersburg Appreciation Day to thank the city for its ongoing support in the evolution and expansion of the campus.

Meet USF St. Petersburg alumnus David Mearns, a marine scientist,

author, and deep sea wreck hunter who is making waves around the world. As director of [Blue Water Recoveries](#), Mearns has found and filmed some of the world's most famous and controversial shipwrecks, including the *HMS Hood* and the *MV Lucona*. Most recently, he and his team discovered the *Esmeralda*, the earliest European ship of discovery that was part of Vasco da Gama's 1502-1503 fleet to India.

In 2010, Means was awarded an honorary Medal of the Order of Australia for his service to the country by finding and filming the wrecks of Australia's two worst maritime disasters, the *HMAS Sydney* and *AHS Centaur*.

His favorite memory from his time at USFSP was during a student trip on the Suncoaster, a ship that had been converted into a research vessel.

"Nearly all my best memories from USF were times spent at sea -- this was one of the reasons I pursued a career working on the oceans," said Mearns.
