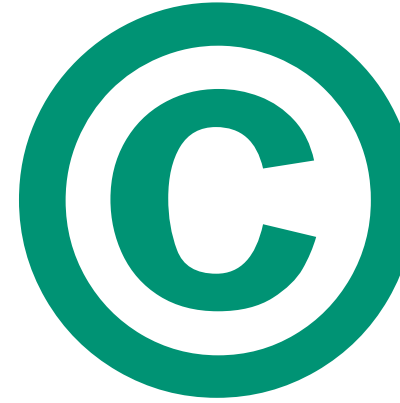

DIGITAL SCHOLARSHIP SERVICES

- 1 Collaborative outreach in the form of a DSS Roadshow that offers departments a choice between Scholarly Communication or Copyright Instruction
- 2 An early focus in the planning stages is sourcing copyright free or openly licensed content



- 1 Locating rights holders begins after necessary content is identified
- 2 This is the time to begin collecting metadata descriptors for data sets
- 3 We can provide assistance on the variety of ways to obtain permissions



- 1 Author rights agreements on all open access journals were crafted for clarity and author empowerment
- 2 We have tools to assist in negotiating author publication contracts
- 3 We can provide assistance on the selection of a CC license for your work
- 4 Publish with us: OA Journals, OA textbooks, Open Educational Resources



Scholar Commons

- 1 We can help you figure out what you can do with your article after publication and we can archive your accepted manuscript in the institutional repository, Scholar Commons
- 2 We can host your open access project, textbook, or collection in Scholar Commons , backed up regularly
- 3 Scholar Commons hosting includes access to discovery metrics that can help you track your impact
