Proposals and syllabi for a new course GEB 3XXX Doing Business in Asia (originally submitted by Ruby Qin as Doing Business in China)

New Course for Doing Business in Asia

At the November meeting, members shelved the proposal by Ruby Qin for a Doing Business in China course. The course had been offered three times as a special studies course. The members felt that the title was too restrictive.

Subsequently, Thompson and Kearns revised the proposal and syllabus to reflect a Doing Business in Asia course that could be offered as a traditional classroom, study abroad or online class. If the course is accepted, proposals for a Doing Business in Europe and Doing Business in Latin America will be developed.

Based on an email vote and reflecting suggested changes, the committee unanimously approved the proposal which was approved by the chair and sent to the Dean's office for approval.

New Courses/Programs Approved by UGC

Rick Smith had submitted syllabi for two new courses: Econ 3013 and Econ 3203. The committee had unanimously approved the proposals and syllabi. The courses were subsequently approved by the campus UGC.
