Approval of Prior Minutes

Discussion of USFSP Get on Board Day

Review of Grant Activity at USFSP

Current external grant activity was presented by Pat Scott. Year to date proposals/requests equals nearly \$11M which is approximately triple the amount at the same time last year. This demonstrates a large increase in grant submissions.

Discussion regarding USF system grants

Dr. Noonan was unable to attend the meeting and thus the committee had minimal discussion on this topic. The committee will invite Dr. Noonan to the first meeting in the spring semester.

Discussion of a Research Award

The committee discussed the creation of a research award for students (undergraduate and graduate). This discussion also included how to link the library to students to help them understand how to access various library services that can aid in their research. An agenda item will be included in a spring meeting and the Dean of the Library will be invited to that meeting.

Discussion of a Student Travel Award

The committee discussed the creation of an award to aid students traveling for research purposes. The committee will further this discussion in the spring semester and invite a member of student government to discuss the possibility of student government providing funding for student travel.
