Message from the Director

The Digital Scholarship Services (DSS) department had an impressive year for 2017/2018, and we continue to grow and expand operations. New areas of expertise in the department include copyright & intellectual property, geographic information systems (GIS), graphic design, web services, and data management. We have an amazing group of individuals working together to round out the department's functions and move us forward.

In the area of marketing and outreach, we've been fleshing out web page resources and diligently working on visiting departments. We also set up a new blog, [Digital Dialogs](#), to discuss new collections that could be of interest to students working on research projects.

Closely tied to outreach is education in the areas of scholarly communication and digital literacy. The [Scholarly Communications Research Lifecycle](#) is now live. There is a new LibGuide on [identifying predatory publishers](#) and some [copyright tutorials](#). The rights statements for both repositories are being updated and clarified, and DSS faculty and staff are doing consultations and outreach for scholarly communication, copyright, and GIS.

In the area of preservation, we have created a preservation plan for the department and set up an Amazon Web Services account. Scholar Commons content is now being preserved there, and we are still organizing data for Digital Collections to upload in the next few months.

In other happy news, the library's institutional repository, Scholar Commons, surpassed *10 million downloads* in January 2018!

In the upcoming year, we'll be redesigning both repository interfaces. We are focusing on metadata to move Digital Collections forward, expanding discovery points for some existing collections and getting metadata documented for recently digitized material that has been waiting for upload. We are excited to see what the upcoming year brings and continually seek ways to serve the research community at USF and beyond.

In 2017-2018, DSS added new services for USF faculty and students that directly support the creation of new collections and partnerships. Some of these include:

- Data management

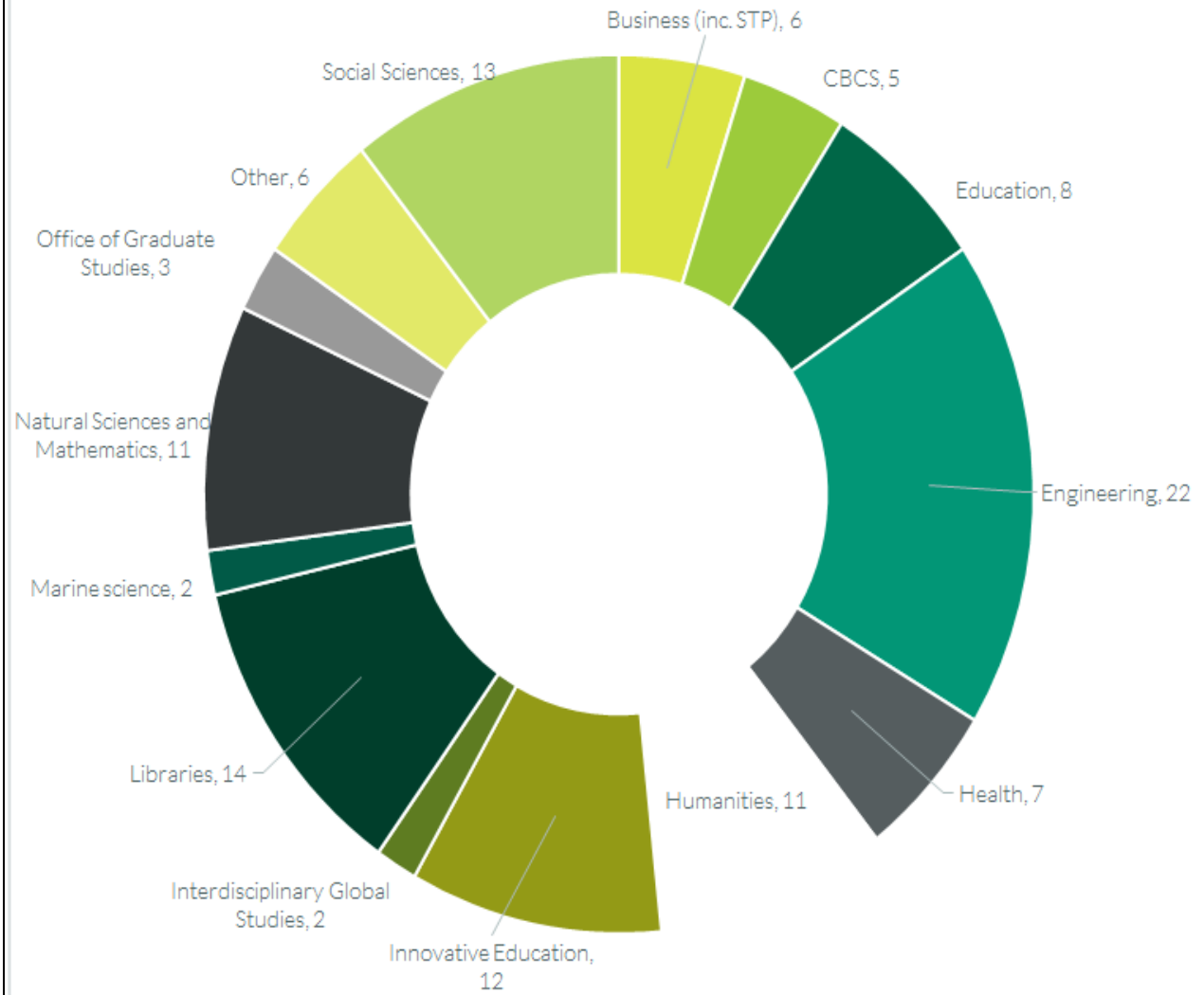
Consultations with librarians and functional specialists are available on request.

The DSS Roadshow was conceived and beta-tested as a method to promote some of these services and to offer cohesive instructional presentations to colleges and departments. A web page for the Roadshow was launched here: <https://www.lib.usf.edu/scholarly-research-and-communication/dss-roadshow/>. An inaugural test session with English Department faculty in the fall was well-received and laid the groundwork for a full launch of the program.

Also primarily instructional in nature, copyright and intellectual property services experienced a 10% increase in contacts from 2016-2017, with 123 questions from faculty, students, and staff. The highest number of questions came from the College of Engineering, followed by the Libraries, Social Sciences, Innovative Education, Natural Sciences and Mathematics, and Humanities.

Questions about use of copyrighted material in Electronic Theses and Dissertations were the most common at 51% of questions received, and were the subject of most graduate inquiries. Teaching followed with 25% of questions.

Upgraded Equipment

- **HP HD Pro 42-inch Scanner:** This replaces the old, outdated Contex Wide Format Scanner. The new HP feed-type scanner will allow us to expand our scanning capability to large maps and charts up to 42 inches.

Design

In August 2017, a group comprised of library staff and faculty skilled in web and graphics design, cataloging, programming, and user experience gathered to devise a plan to redesign the front end of our SobekCM repository. The group reviewed several reputable university and public library digital collections sites and created a “wish list” of their favorite features, with consideration for aesthetics, language, functionality, navigability, and access. Our Graphics Designer, Rachel Gillespie, designed a mock-up version of the user interface, with input from our Systems Administrator, Richard Bernardy, and our Web Front End Developer, Trevor Collinson. Programming commenced with scheduled reviews of the development site and input from the entire design group over a period of several months. The final interface was then merged with the most up-to-date version of the repository software. The new site is scheduled to go live by the beginning of the Fall 2018 semester.

The Scholar Commons repository was also redesigned, with a color scheme and graphics to complement the Digital Collections interface. Bepress is scheduled to move this design into production concurrent with the Digital Collections redesign in August 2018.

Featured Projects: Digital Collections

Archaeology in St. Pete Parks (323 items)

A number of archaeological and cultural heritage sites are located on lands owned by the City of St. Petersburg Parks and Recreation, and as part of a preservation and management effort, these properties are being mapped and documented using the latest in 3D survey technologies. The goal of this project is to provide a better understanding of these resources, as well as produce meaningful interpretation experiences for park visitors and other interested persons.

Environmental Land Acquisitions Protection Program (ELAPP) (342 items)

In 1987, Hillsborough County voters approved a referendum and property tax to implement the Environmental Lands Acquisition and Protection Program (ELAPP). ELAPP has protected over 61,000 acres of rare and important habitat in Hillsborough County. The ELAPP history project was funded by a generous donation from Gus Muench.

Pasco County Sinkhole, Lake Saxon, Florida (252 items)

The University of South Florida Library's Digital Heritage and Humanities Collections (DHHC) researchers conducted a 3D survey of the Pasco County sinkhole near Saxon Lake. The DHHC and USF Libraries are creating this database archive of the research effort, and a web application portal that shares historic maps and information about the environmental history of this area.

SNAPS (3 items)

SNAPS was published weekly by Frank Tousey from 1899 to 1901. Our collection offers 3 of the 72 titles in the series. Each 32-page issue contained humorous stories written by authors with pseudonyms like Peter Pad, Tom Teaser, and Sam Smiley.

Tampa Life newspaper (41 items)

Former municipal judge (and legislator) Leo Stalnaker and other partners formed the newspaper *Tampa Life* in 1929 to report on the corruption in the city that the other local papers seemed to ignore. The paper went out of business in 1930. Only a few of the issues survive, but they offer a valuable glimpse into the minds of “dry” advocates in a very “wet” town.

Oral Histories

Environmental Lands Acquisition and Protection Program Oral History Project

This project expands our LGBT collection through our partnership with Dr. Tara Deubel, Assistant Professor of Anthropology at USF, and Mark Canavera. So far, we have received 7 oral histories. Holocaust Survivors Oral History Project

The library added to our Holocaust Survivors Oral History Project this year when Terry Howard interviewed Simone D’Addario. The interview is nearly 4 hours long and conducted in two sessions. Ms. D’Addario was a child during the German occupation of France during World War II. During her interview she recalls memories of her father’s involvement with the underground French resistance, her family’s homelessness after their houses were bombed or taken by the Germans, and the tragic deaths of classmates and neighbors.

USF Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders 50th Anniversary Oral History Program

In 1967, The University of South Florida added a five year degree known as Communicology. Over the last 50 years, the Department of Communicology has experienced immense changes and growth, becoming what we know today as the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD). In honor of CSD's 50th anniversary, graduate student Stephanie de Silva, with the help of undergraduate students Mary Aragona and Taylor Baber, conducted interviews of USF CSD alumni and previous faculty who shared their experiences in USF CSD over the decades and the programs that helped shape their successful careers.

Featured Projects: Scholar Commons

Quality Control Project

With the assistance of student employees, the quality control project for Scholar Commons, which began in 2015, is scheduled to conclude at the end of 2018. Every record in Scholar Commons will have been reviewed and corrected. This entails checking that all links work and including a DOI if available. At the end of the project, each record will have a standardization of fields, such as authors and citations, to give Scholar Commons' records consistency.

OA Textbooks Collection

Our OA Textbook Collection was Scholar Commons' second most downloaded collection (after ETDs) with 558,759 downloads. With 470,905 downloads, our most downloaded textbook was Anol Bhattacharjee's *Social Science Research: Principles, Methods, and Practices*. The second most downloaded textbook was William F. Trench's *Student Solutions Manual for Elementary Differential Equations and Elementary Differential Equations with Boundary Value Problems* with 65,923 downloads. The third most used textbook, with 12,548 downloads, was *Journalism 2.0: How to Survive and Thrive* by Mark Briggs.

Scholar Commons provides a page for sponsoring faculty member(s) to centralize their conference information. Because the sites are hosted in Scholar Commons, they enjoy the platform's discoverability benefits. ETD Collection

The Electronic Theses & Dissertations (ETDs) in Scholar Commons is one of the largest and most heavily used portions of the repository. There are 7,103 ETDs currently in the collection, which have been used a total of 6,492,260 times. Rather than having to request a print copy of a dissertation through interlibrary loan, ETDs are easily discoverable online through the repository. Our ETDs are harvested by the Networked Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations (NDLTD) and are preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network.

Journal Collection

Scholar Commons now hosts 20 journals in the USF institutional repository. One new journal went live this year, *Journal of Global Education and Research*. We have also added 11 back issues of *Saw Palm*, a journal on Florida literature and art from the Creative Writing Program at the University of South Florida.

Open access journals allow researchers across the world 24/7 access to research that has traditionally kept behind a subscription firewall or limited to a few physical print copies. Twelve of our journals are peer-reviewed, keeping to the same quality standards as traditional journals. Two of our journals are included in Scopus (*International Journal of Speleology* and *Journal of Strategic Security*) and two have an impact factor (*International Journal of Speleology* and *Journal of Public Transportation*).

Subject matter is varied, ranging from geology to homeland security to the humanities. Nine titles are in the Global LOCKSS Network, with the remaining titles being preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network. LOCKSS is a geographically distributed archiving system, ensuring that this content is available even if something were to happen to the repository itself. We also work with Portico to archive Scholar Commons journal content in their dark archive.

Periodically, and as requested, statistics for all journals are pulled and analyzed. For our top journals, we are able to pull additional Google Analytics.

The central Scholar Commons email is consistently monitored for journal activity and forwarded as needed. Assistance and training for journal editors are provided as requested.

Karst Information Portal

In the 2017/2018 year, there were 740,198 downloads for 3,992 records publicly available through KIP. This was the result from 97,818 unique visits or sessions. 59 titles were added to the collection, comprising 2,798 pages of content. An additional 56 records were added which link to external resources. At the same page count average per title for locally loaded content we added facilitated access to another 2,655 pages of content.

KIP continues to draw in additional users by maintaining the karstportal.org and karstinfo.org domains coupled with a global and item-level dynamic redirection service.

KIP enjoys a close relationship with Dr. George Veni, Executive Director of the National Cave and Karst Research Institute. Dr. Veni serves as our informal liaison with the greater Karst research community.

Statistics for Digital Collections

Much of the efforts in Digital Collections this past year were to enhance metadata for existing collections, so the number of items added was fairly low. Digital Collections added 1,263 items to Digital Collections, bringing the total to 61,224, a 1% increase over last year. Eight new collections were added this year, bringing the total to 181, a 5% increase. Usage skyrocketed with 6,022,262 total views of the collection.

Statistics for Scholar Commons

Lifetime full-text downloads for Scholar Commons have grown 20.7% percent from 8,765,438 to 10,490,288.

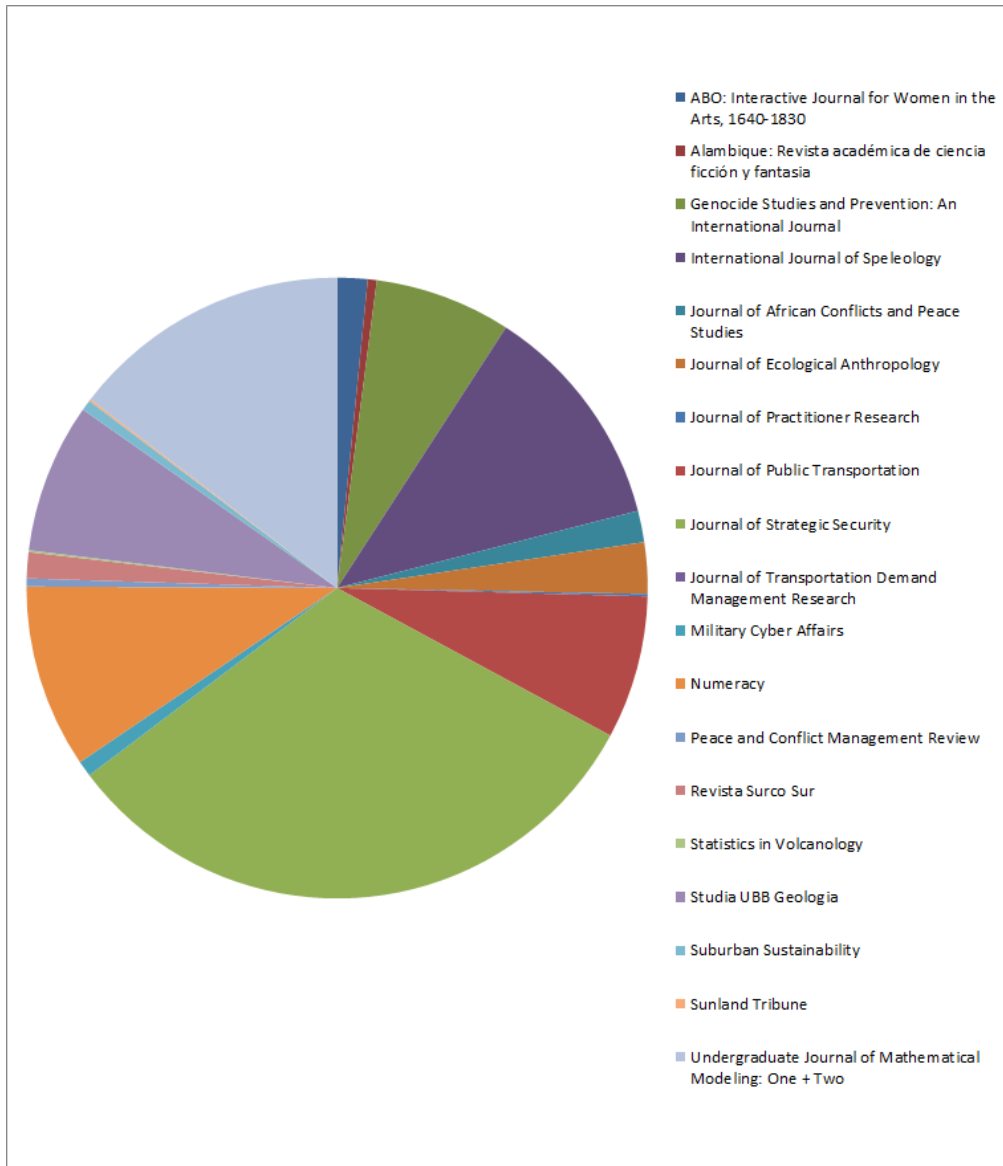
Open access academic journals, the original reason for the creation of this initiative, have consistently added new content. The ETD collection continues to receive some of our greatest download statistics. The Open Access Textbook collection is also a top downloaded collection in Scholar Commons.

Since 2013, the top downloaded item has been Anol Bhattacharjee's OA textbook, *Social Science Research: Principles, Methods, and Practices*. Dr. Bhattacharjee's textbook was added to Scholar Commons in 2011. This item has now has 559,302 full-text downloads of the English version (the six translations have received a collective 51,913 downloads since being added). From July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018, *Social Science Research* received an impressive 104,551 downloads. While the total downloads may not put OA Textbooks as the most heavily used series, individual items within this collection have received some of our highest usage.

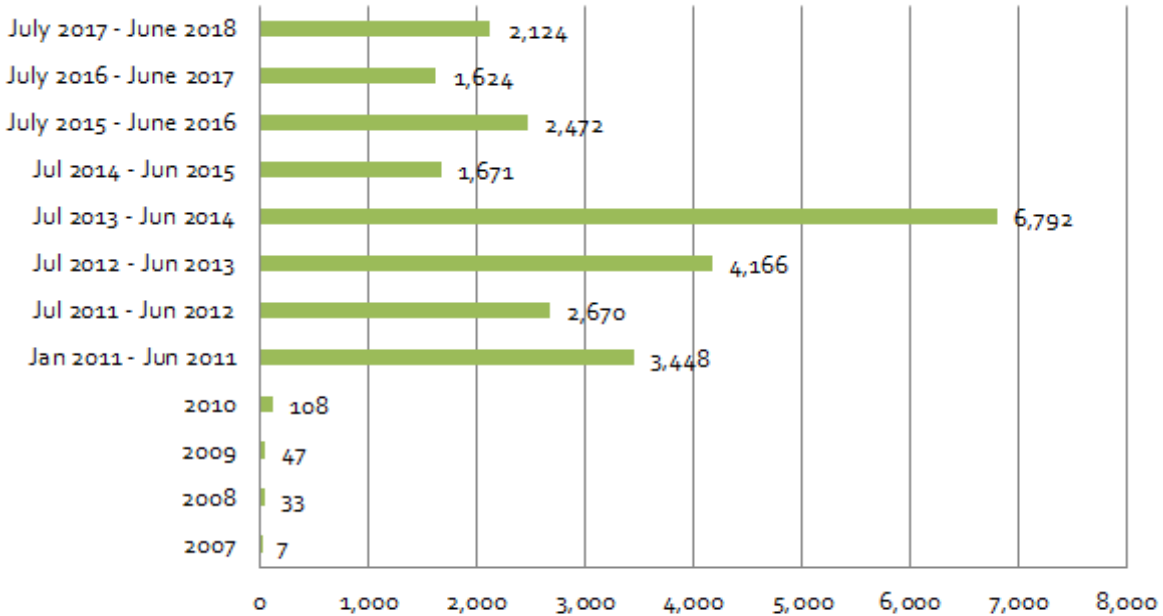

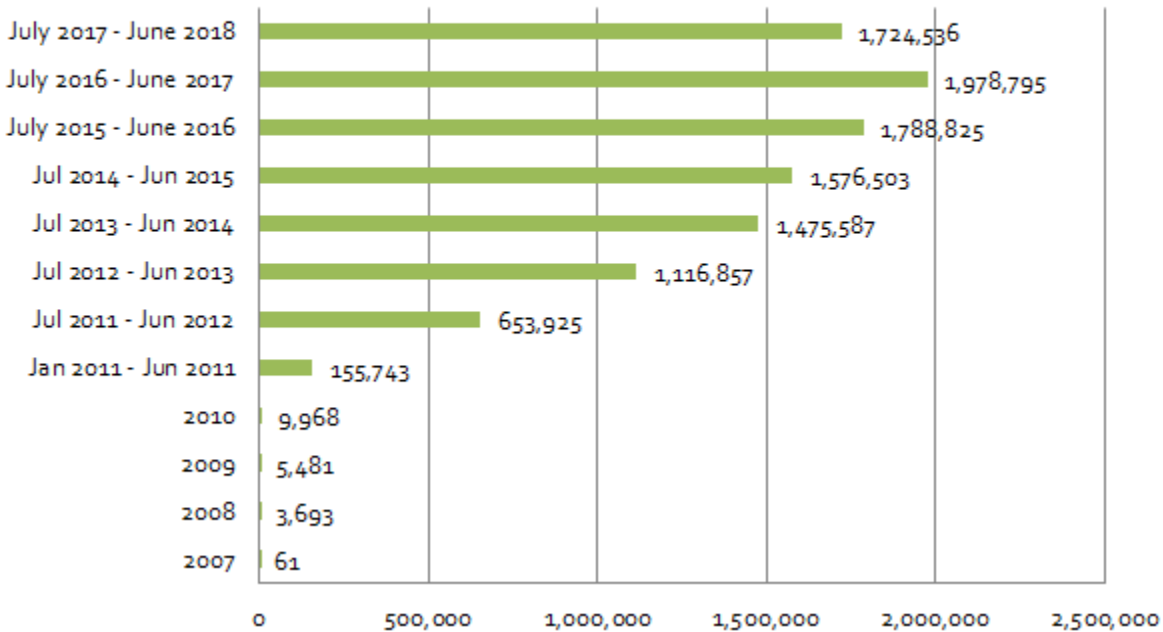
