## Message from Director

The University of South Florida Libraries' Digital Scholarship Services (DSS) has just completed its first three years as a department, bringing us to the close of our original strategic plan. As we receive new requests for projects, this plan provides a framework to help determine if each project is a good fit for the department's mission. We will be evaluating our progress and working on a new plan starting with the 2019/2020 academic year.

We have wonderful staff news to report. LeEtta Schmidt, Copyright and Intellectual Property Librarian, was the American Library Association's (ALA) very first winner of the Reference and User Services Association (RUSA) Sharing and Transforming Access to Resources Section (STARS) Publication Recognition Award. LeEtta is being recognized for a chapter she co-authored with J. Silvia Cho, "Sharing Digital Collections and Content," in the book *Library Information and Resource Sharing: Transforming Services and Collections*, edited by Beth Posner. Congratulations, LeEtta!



We are delighted to welcome two Collections Specialists to the DSS department this year as well. Carla Fotherby now has a permanent staff position working with Jason Boczar on data management and the C-IMAGE grants, and Matt Bargainer joined us to work on oral histories. I, too, moved into a new role, and am now Assistant Dean as of August 2018. I am appreciative of the help and support I've received from my DSS team while making the transition, as they've truly stepped up to keep things humming along. In other staff news, we've had a few staff members depart for other positions this past year. Rachel Gillespie, Megan Nowell, and Chelsea Johnston are sorely missed, but we are excited to watch their surely successful careers flourish.

In addition, our two main repositories had a redesign. [Scholar Commons](#) and [Digital Collections](#) have new interfaces with similar design elements to keep a consistent brand across the departments. Both repositories switched over to https from http, providing a more secure connection for information to be sent through both sites. Digital Collections now has consistent rights statements for our hundreds of collections, allowing people to more easily determine how (or if) items can be reused. We also have a new [copyright portal](#) available, which assists patrons in navigating a wealth of copyright information available to them.

LeEtta Schmidt, Chelsea Johnston, and Jason Boczar created the [DSS Roadshow](#) as an outreach tool to educate faculty about copyright and scholarly communications services available to them. Information is available online or in handout form, and they developed a packaged presentation which greatly reduces the work required to organize new informational sessions. Faculty can select to learn about one of the two tracks, or both.

We have several new collections and newly enhanced collections. One in particular involved us working closely with Dr. Chip Stanish, Director of the Institute for the Advanced Study of Culture

in the Environment, and his graduate assistant, Christine Bergmann, to set up a proof of concept for the [Huaca Soto Collection](#). This collection includes images and descriptions of archaeological artifacts and was created as a proof of concept to make Dr. Stanish's original research material available online for other researchers to access and use. Dr. Stanish reports that his work with the Library, and being able to show how his research could be made available online as open access (OA), helped him in his National Science Foundation (NSF) grant proposal.

I'm so impressed with the work the DSS team is accomplishing, and I'm sure you will be, too. Read on to learn more!

- Explore applications of emerging technologies

## DSS Roadshow

The DSS Roadshow (<https://www.lib.usf.edu/scholarly-research-and-communication/dss-roadshow/>) was developed to enhance the outreach endeavors of scholarly communications and copyright services by offering a choice of two instructional tracks: one dedicated to scholarly communication issues and one focusing on issues encountered when using copyrighted material in instruction. The Roadshow is designed to be delivered to the faculty in a department at whatever existing meeting time is available. In 2018/19, the Roadshow visited the English department LIT 2000 instructors in fall and gave an introductory session for the Department of Teaching and Learning in spring.

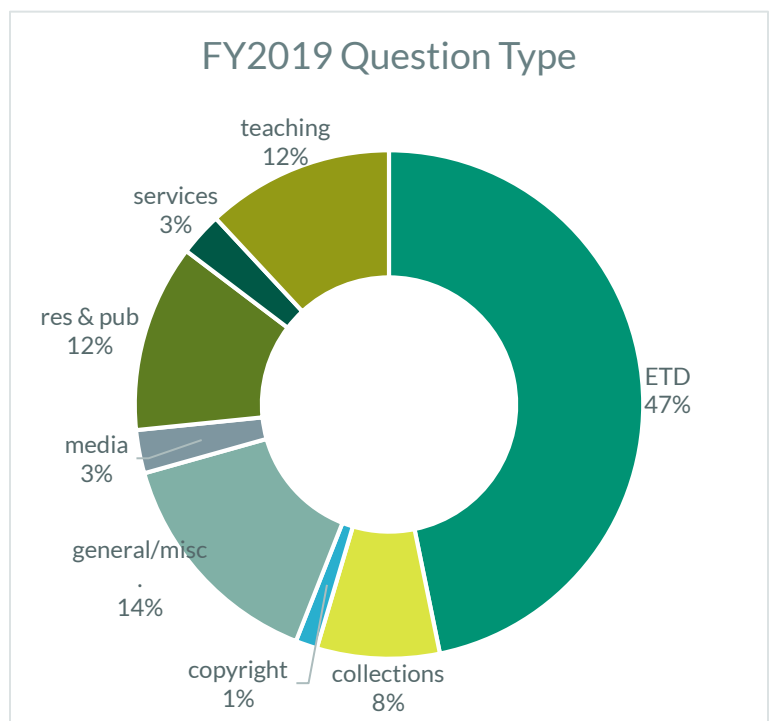
## Copyright and Intellectual Property

Copyright and Intellectual Property Services experienced an increase of 77% in questions during 2018/19FY compared to the previous year, at 218 questions received. The highest number of these were from Engineering, followed by the School of Sciences & Mathematics, and the Libraries.

Questions about the use of copyrighted material in electronic theses and dissertations were the most common at 47% of questions received and were the subject of most graduate inquiries. Teaching was the second most common question type with 26% of questions. Questions regarding research and publication rose from 5% in 2018FY to 12% in 2019FY.

## Data Management

DSS offers assistance with Data Management needs for researchers. This includes data management planning as well as hosting datasets. DSS created the following page to

During the 2018/2019FY, we met with Cassandra Smith, a Geosciences graduate student, about hosting open access volcanic lightning data. DSS met with Dr. Smith, helped create a metadata schema, and gathered all of the necessary files, which totaled over 5TB. The next stage of the project will take place during the 2019/2020FY. This stage includes adding and making available Dr. Smith's data in the USF Digital Collections.

## Center for Integrated Modeling & Analysis of the Gulf Ecosystem (C-IMAGE)

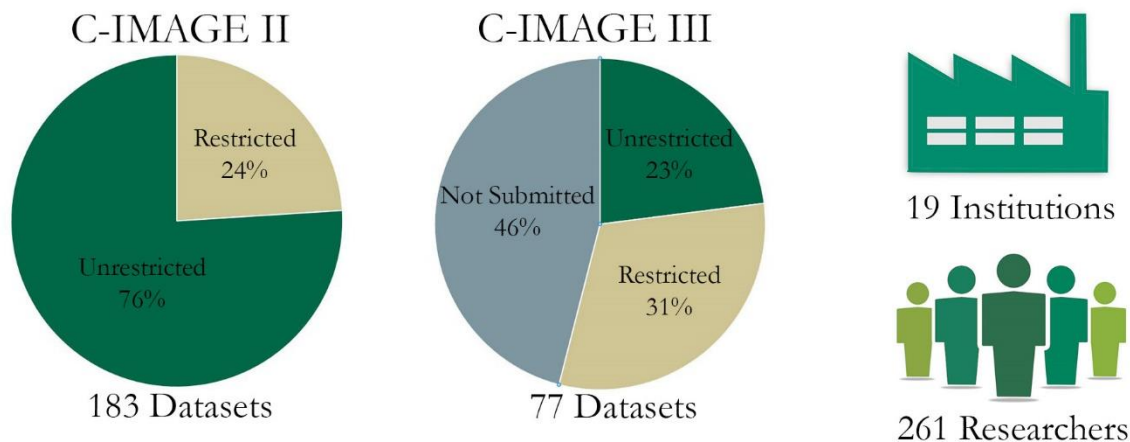
The Center for Integrated Modeling & Analysis of the Gulf Ecosystem (C-IMAGE) (<https://www.marine.usf.edu/c-image/>) is a consortium studying the long-term impact of the DWH and IXTOC-1 spills on the Gulf of Mexico ecosystems. The USF Tampa Library's Data Management Team assisted the consortium with the successful close out of C-IMAGE II (RFP-IV) during the 2018-2019FY and then transitioned to fully supporting C-IMAGE III (RFP-VI), the final state of the investigation.

### C-IMAGE II

All 183 identified datasets were submitted on time; the majority of the datasets are unrestricted and available for public download through the dataset monitoring site operated by the Gulf of Mexico Research Initiative Information & Data Cooperative (GRIIDC) (<https://data.gulfresearchinitiative.org/pelagos-symfony/dataset-monitoring#10/267>). The library's data management team will continue to monitor and assist with this project until all datasets are available for public download.

### C-IMAGE III

Seventy-seven datasets were identified and approved by GRIIDC. A portion of the identified datasets has been submitted and is available for public download through GRIIDC's dataset monitoring site (<https://data.gulfresearchinitiative.org/pelagos-symfony/dataset-monitoring#802/805>). The remaining datasets are expected to be submitted the subsequent fiscal year.

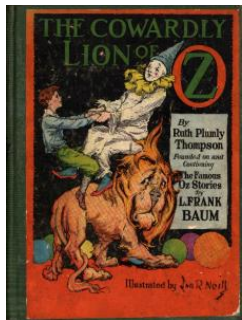

## Featured Projects

### Digitization in Celebration



In honor of **Hispanic Heritage Month** and this year's theme, "Hispanics: One Endless Voice to Enhance our Traditions," Digital Scholarship Services has digitized a small selection of seven musical and theatrical materials from our Special Collections Sheet Music and Centro Asturiano Collections, including five Spanish lyric-dramatic plays called zarzuelas.

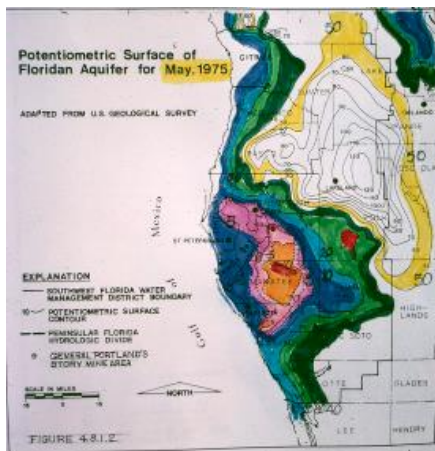


In January 2019, Digital Scholarship Services selected 19 materials, based on a popular vote, to add to our digital collections to celebrate the long-awaited movement of the **public domain**. The nineteen materials enhanced five existing digital collections. Seven books were added to the Children's Literature collection, three to the Florida Studies Collection, one to our digitized books on the Natural Sciences, three new titles were added to the Science Fiction collection, and five pieces were added to the recently established digital Sheet Music collection.

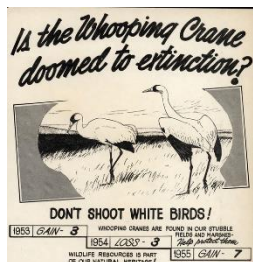


In honor of **African American History Month**, Digital Scholarship Services added to the new digital Sheet Music Collection by digitizing a selection of sheet music from the USF Libraries' African American Sheet Music Collection. Forty-two pieces were added to the collection and featured in an online exhibit, "[Swing Along! The Music of Early African American Composers.](#)"

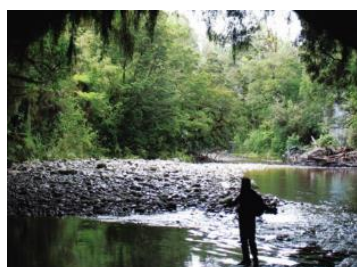
### Environmental Collections



**Dr. Garald Gordon Parker** (1905-2000), often cited as the "Father of Florida groundwater hydrogeology," had a long career studying and preserving groundwater resources, particularly in Florida. Dr. Parker donated his papers to Special Collections before he died. After interest was expressed from a PBS documentary series, Digital Collections made contact with the family to investigate the possibility of providing greater access to this collection through digitization. Twenty-nine materials have been added to this new collection and faculty in Geosciences have recently indicated materials that they would like to see digitized next.



**Robert Porter Allen** was an ornithologist and conservation activist with the National Audubon Society. A second batch of new Robert Porter Allen Collection content was added to this digital collection. This batch consisted of 900 images including field notes and documentation of migration patterns and habitats from 1940-1960.



**Karst Information Portal** is an open-access digital library that links scientists, managers, and explorers to quality information resources in order to inform research, enhance collaboration, and address policy decisions concerning karst environments. Continued development of this portal included the addition of conference proceedings and journal issues as well as a user experience analysis to plan upcoming enhancements.

## Huaca Soto



In 2014 and 2015, Dr. Charles Stanish conducted an archeological excavation on the **Huaca Soto** site, located in southern Peru's Chincha Valley. This excavation revealed a sunken court structure that was occupied during the Paracas period, 800 BCE to 100 BCE. Since 2017, DSS staff have been working with Dr. Stanish and graduate student Christine Bergmann at the USF Institute for the Advanced Study of Culture and the Environment to organize, describe, and present photographs and field notes documenting the effort to preserve the material culture of Huaca Soto. The Andean

Archaeological Data Project provides anyone interested in South American archaeology with open access to all aspects of data gathered and collected in and out of the field.

## Geosciences Collection in Scholar Commons

With support from the Research Platform Teams, huge strides were made for the School of Geosciences collection in Scholar Commons. This department has historically been well represented in Scholar Commons, but their participation increased by including new faculty members' and many graduate students' works. Most of the participants also requested SelectedWorks profiles be created for them.

## Oral History Program

Oral histories are an increasingly important source of primary research for students and faculty who seek to understand and interpret the past through the experiences of participants. Students and scholars worldwide have online, open access to these primary source materials. Each hour of interview time requires over 20 hours of labor to edit and transcribe the audio as well as conduct quality control checks. Though this is a time-intensive process, we believe the resulting product is worth the time and effort.



- NEW: DSS has partnered with Dr. Tara Deubel, Mark Canavera, and graduate students from the USF Anthropology department to present the Out Down South collection, which documents the coming-out experiences of gays and lesbians from the Southeastern United States. (<https://digital.lib.usf.edu/ohp-outdownsouth>)
- In Process: Terry Howard, who recorded oral histories for the Oculina Bank Oral History Project (2010), has been conducting interviews with Florida Fishing Captains, documenting the experiences of multiple generations of Atlantic fishing captains with a specific focus on changes in the ocean environment and the impact of the commercial fishing industry.
- In Process: The expansion of the Environmental Land Acquisition and Protection Program (ELAPP) oral histories is in progress, recording the memories of dedicated scientists and environmentalists involved in the race to preserve environmental land and wildlife habitat in Hillsborough County, FL. (<https://digital.lib.usf.edu/OHP-ELAPP>)
- Continuing: Work on the USF 50th Anniversary oral histories continues. These histories include the experiences of USF's first faculty, the founding of the university, and the challenges and celebrations of its rapid rise to become one of the leading universities in the state. (<https://digital.lib.usf.edu/OHP-USF50>)

## Selected Works Faculty Profiles

A new emphasis was placed on faculty profiles in SelectedWorks. This includes cleaning up profiles that are no longer affiliated with USF to encouraging faculty members to have profiles created for them while their work is being added to Scholar Commons.

- There are 240 total SelectedWorks profiles.
- Sixty-seven profiles were created during 2018/2019FY.



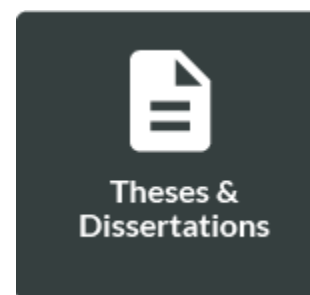
The department affiliations of new SelectedWorks profiles was wide-ranging with 21 departments represented. The top three are a direct result of outreach activities. The School of Geosciences (42%) was a result of the Geosciences Research Platform Team. The department of Teaching and Learning (14%) occurred after a presentation of the DSS Roadshow. The Center for Urban Transportation Research (8%) is a result of a department meeting and a long-standing relationship with our open access journals.

## OA Textbooks Collection

Our OA Textbook Collection ([https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/oa\\_textbooks](https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/oa_textbooks)) was Scholar Commons' second most downloaded collection (after ETDs) with 968,791 all-time downloads. With 693,588 all-time downloads, our most downloaded textbook was Anol Bhattacharjee's *Social Science Research: Principles, Methods, and Practices*. The second most downloaded textbook was William F. Trench's *Student Solutions Manual for Elementary Differential Equations and Elementary Differential Equations with Boundary Value Problems* with 112,181 downloads. The third most used textbook, with 16,490 downloads, was *Journalism 2.0: How to Survive and Thrive* by Mark Briggs.

## ETD Collection

The Electronic Theses & Dissertations (ETDs) in Scholar Commons (<https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/etd/>) is one of the largest and most heavily used portions of the repository. There are 7,645 ETDs currently in the collection, which have been used a total of 7,625,169 times. Rather than having to request a print copy of a dissertation through interlibrary loan, ETDs are easily discoverable online through the repository. Our ETDs are harvested by the Networked Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations (NDLTD) and are preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network.



## OA Journal Collection

Open access journals (<https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/journals.html>) allow researchers across the world 24/7 access to research that has traditionally been kept behind a subscription firewall or limited to a few physical print copies. Twelve of our journals are peer-reviewed, keeping to the same quality standards as traditional journals. Two of our journals are included in Scopus (*International Journal of Speleology* and *Journal of Strategic Security*) and two have an impact factor (*International Journal of Speleology* and *Journal of Public Transportation*).



Subject matter is varied, ranging from geology to homeland security to the humanities. Nine titles are in the Global LOCKSS Network, with the remaining titles being preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network. LOCKSS is a geographically distributed archiving system, ensuring that this content is available even if something were to happen to the repository itself. We also work with Portico to archive Scholar Commons' journal content in their dark archive.

## Interface Redesign

In 2018/19, the redesign of Digital Collections on SobekCM and of the Scholar Commons Institutional Repository was completed and launched. This was a culmination of a project begun in August of 2017, led by the DSS Graphic Designer, Rachel Gillespie; Systems Administrator, Richard Bernardy; and the Web Front End Developer, Trevor Collinson.





## Copyright Information Pages

USF Libraries Digital Scholarship Services department completed a project to completely update our rights statements with clearer, more standardized, statements based on [RightsStatements.org](#). Every collection and sub-collection was reviewed to determine the rights status of items in digital collections and then assigned a rights statement that was appropriate and clear.

In addition, a Copyright and Terms of Use information page (<https://www.lib.usf.edu/copyright/>) was created for the library to explain the rights statements in Digital Collections as well as rights and user issues across many library areas.

Finally, a Copyright and Intellectual Property portal (<https://www.lib.usf.edu/dss/copyright-and-intellectual-property/>) was created to improve patron experience using the Copyright LibGuide. The portal establishes two layers of web pages that ask users about the nature of their questions in order to funnel them directly to the material in the LibGuide that most suits their questions.

## Digital Collections Activity and Statistics

The use of digital collections may have been impacted by the redesign that launched at the beginning of the fiscal year. There was a 24% decrease in collection views from 2017/18. There were 10,364 items added across all collections, 3,543 of which belonged to ten new collections.

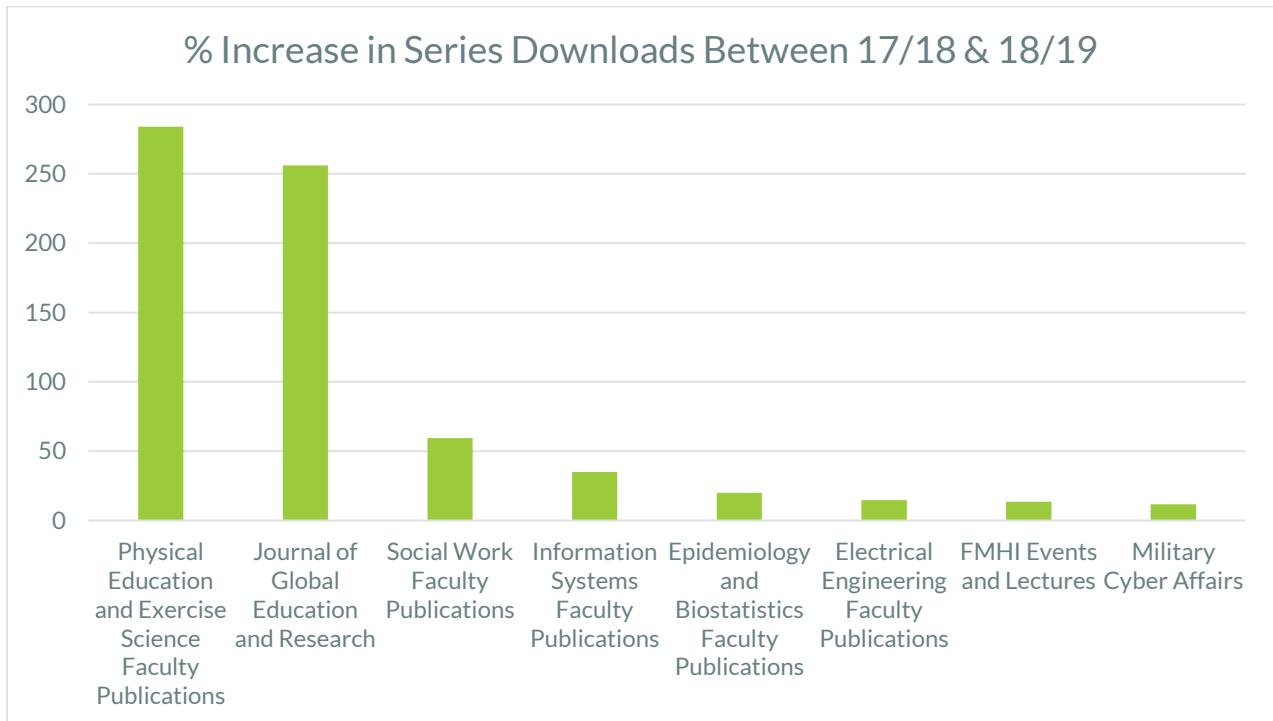

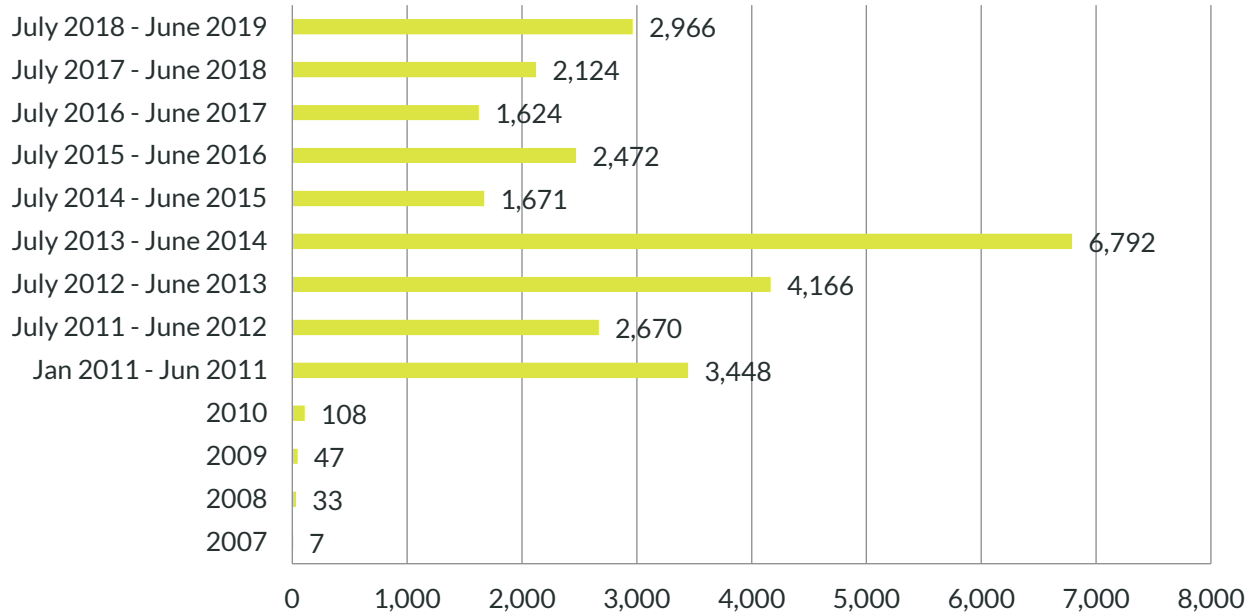

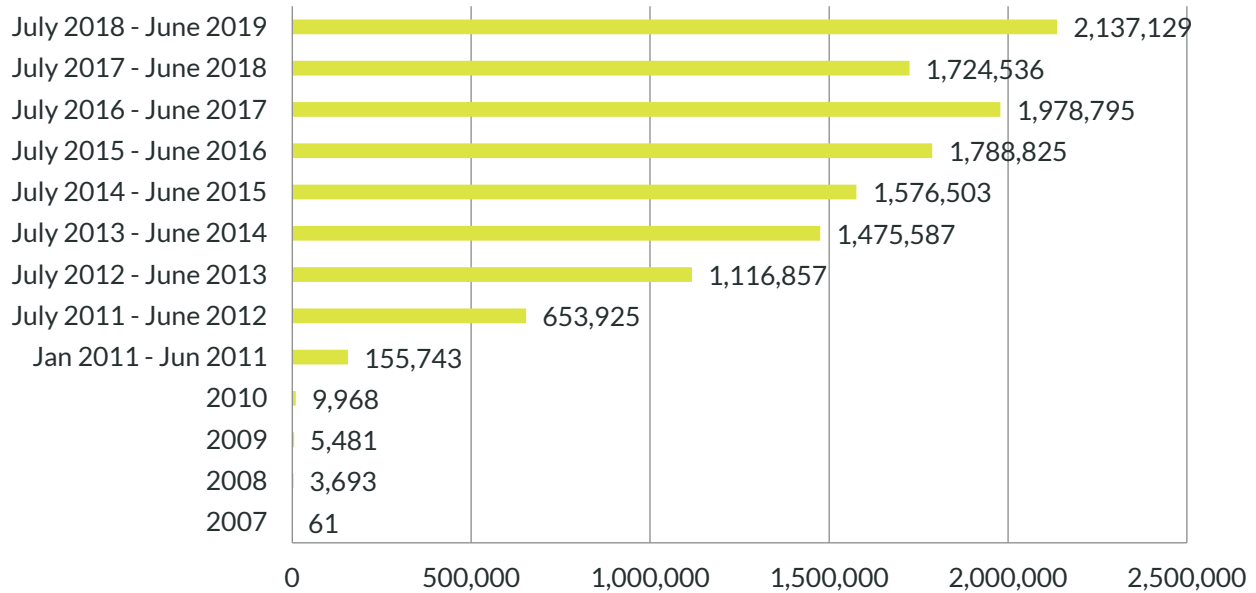




## Total Full-Text Items Added Each Year Dec 2007 - Jun 2019

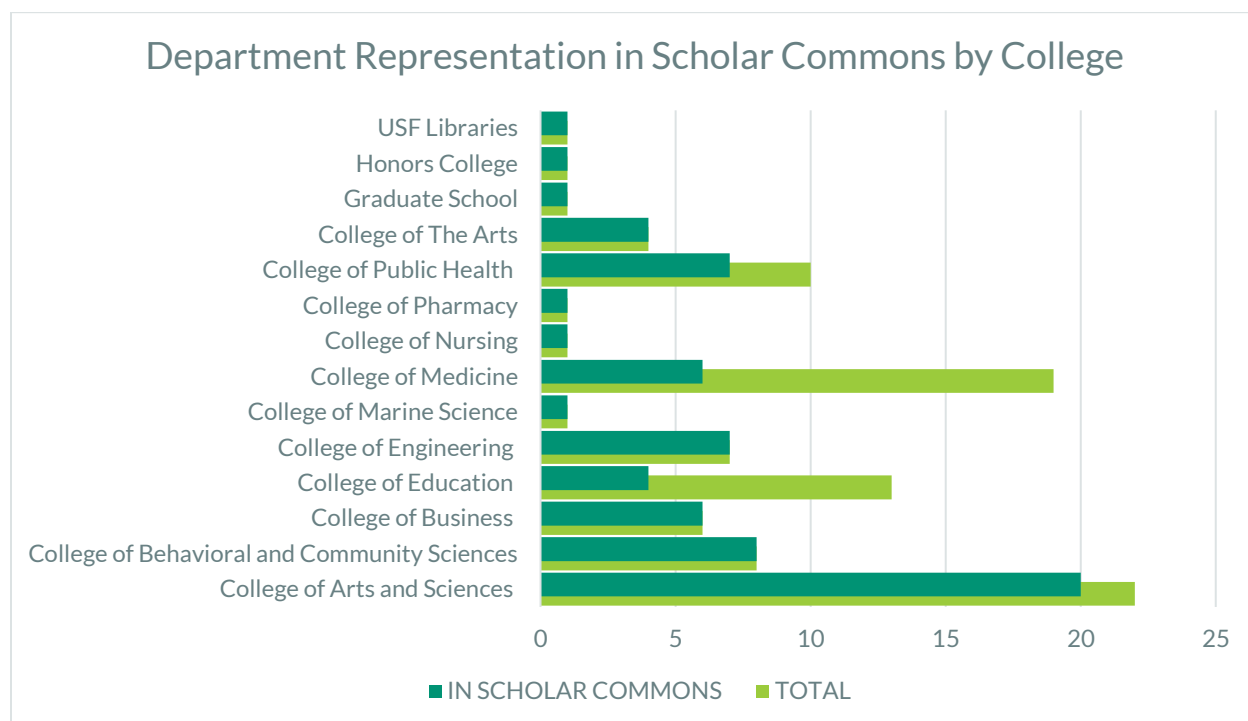


## Full-Text Downloads per Year Dec 2007 - Jun 2019

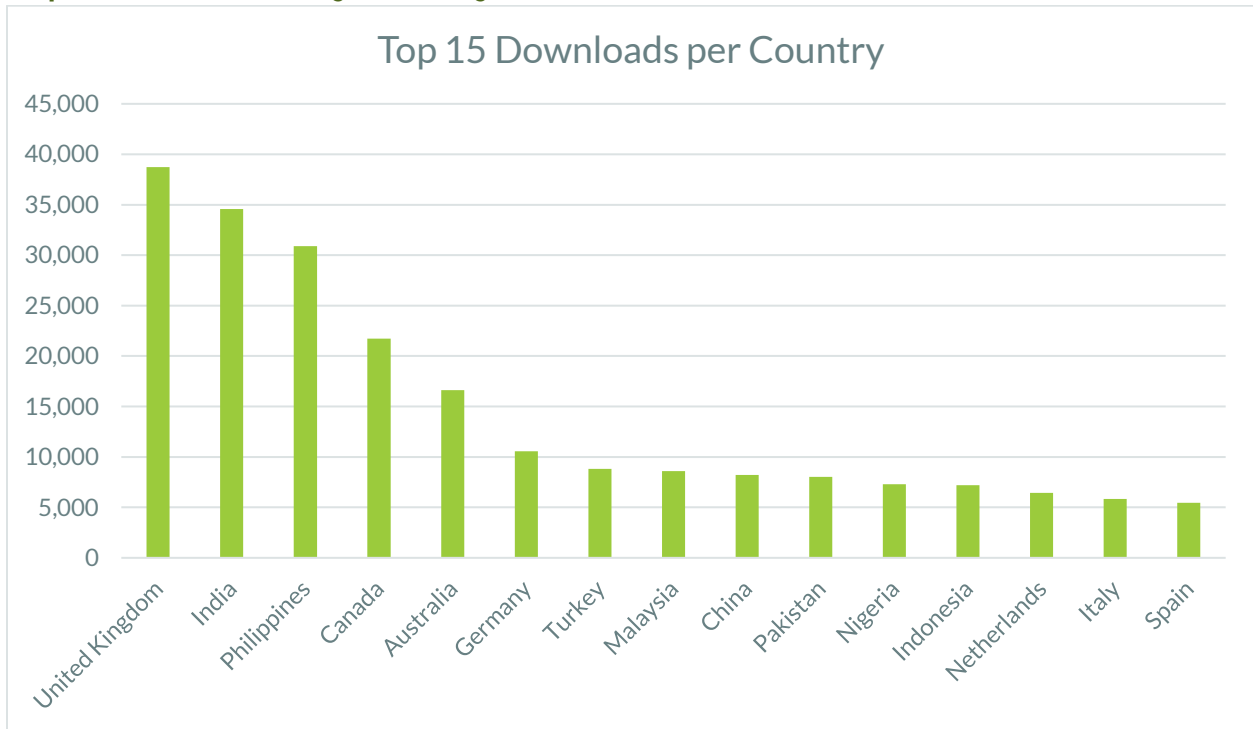
