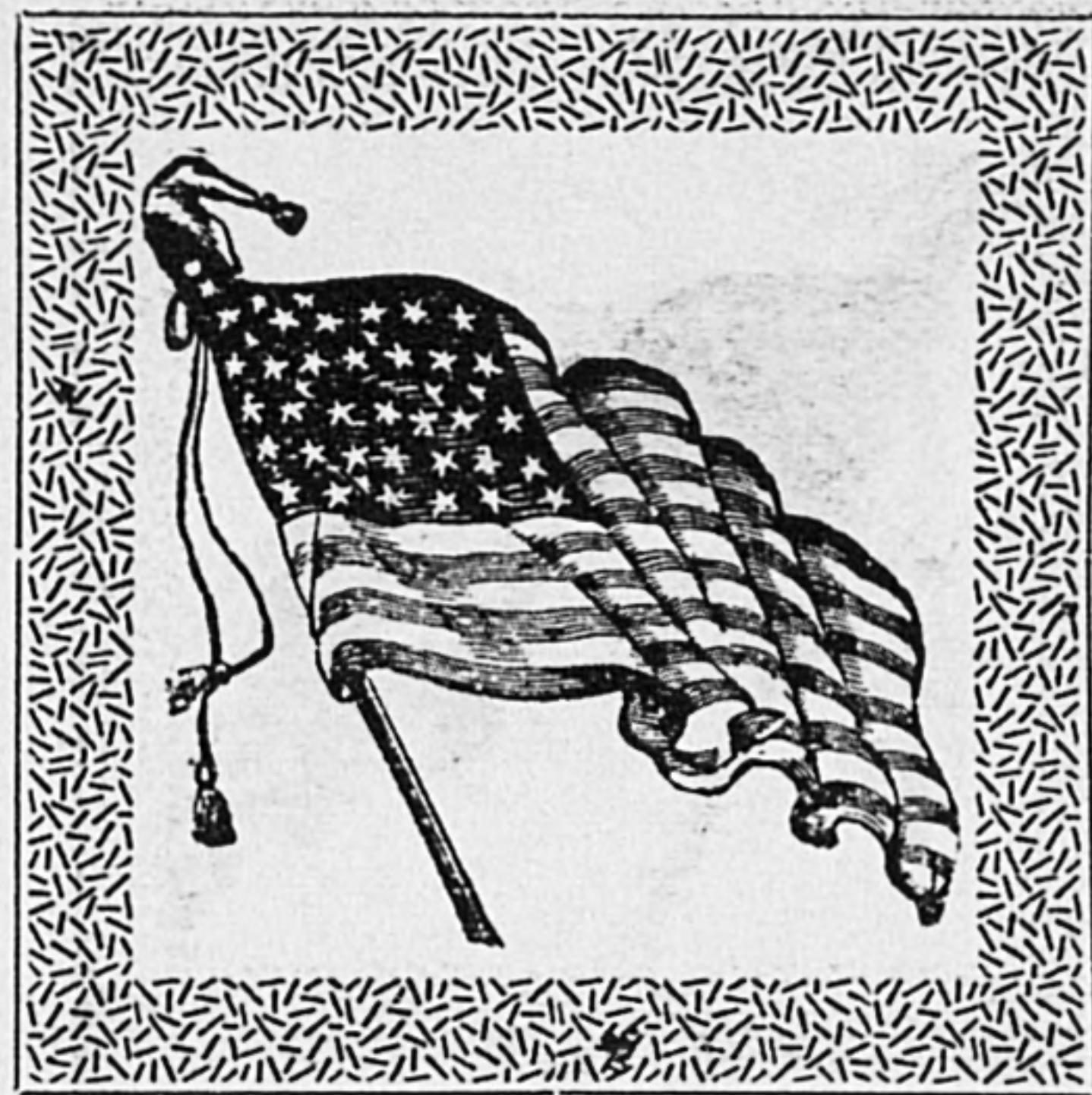

 in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida (the said court having a common law jurisdiction, and a Clerk and Seal, and being a  
 Court of Record), and applied to the said Court to be admitted to become a **CITIZEN** of the United States of America, pursuant to the directions and  
 acquisitions of the several acts of Congress in relation thereto; and the said applicant  
 having produced to the Court such declarations and renunciations, and taken such oaths as are by such acts required:

and it appearing that said applicant is over the age of twenty one years  
 Therefore, It is ordered that the said Alfredo Corso be admitted, and he is accordingly admitted  
 by said Court to be a **CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.**
