Message from Director

The University of South Florida Libraries' Digital Scholarship Services (DSS) has had another great year, even with the interruption of the COVID-19 pandemic in mid-March. From March 18 to date, the DSS team has been fully working from home—and did a fabulous job with that transition. I cannot overstate how impressed I am by this group's flexibility as they proved that they work just as well (if not better) at home. We had very little notice of the transition, and the DSS team was even able to shift our student assistant workers to an online environment to keep them productive and employed.

A big focus this year has been the Florida Environment & Natural History collections. The DSS department has been working very closely with Special Collections and the Research Platform Teams to develop and digitize collections in this area. All of the available online or paper collections have been collected together in a single



interface, the <u>Florida Environmental Interface</u> (FEI). There are new digital collections in process for the <u>Lorida Audubon Collection</u>, 1935-2010 (not a misspelling; there really is a Lorida, Florida) and the new <u>Dr. John Ogden Florida and Caribbean Reef Collection</u>, which documents 30 years of Dr. Ogden's research excursions. We have also been expanding existing collections, such as the Robert Porter Allen Audubon and Dr. Garald Gordon Parker collections. Scholar Commons has packaged and expanded faculty and student research in environment and natural history in a new collection, <u>Environment and Natural History Publications</u>, including materials dating back to 1971. Our new Research Assistant, Emily Holbrooke, has been conducting oral history interviews in this area, including many new items added to the Environmental and Lands Acquisition Protection Program Oral History Project. Additionally, several members of the DSS department worked with Special Collections to document their Florida Environment & Natural History (FLENH) Business Plan.

In response to the protests and demonstrations against racial injustice, the dean asked the library to collate our African American materials into a new African American Experience (AAE) interface, similar to the FEI format. Members of DSS are again working closely with Special Collections and others in the library to create the AAE interface in the coming year, which will mean more digitization in that area in future.

In other news, the three former University of South Florida institutions—USF Tampa, USF St. Petersburg, and USF Sarasota-Manatee—consolidated (back) into a single university on July 1, 2020. We look forward to working with our colleagues in the other campus libraries, and our webmaster Trevor Collinson is busily working away on massaging the USF Libraries web presence to reflect a single institution. In addition to our new Research Assistant, we have another new hire in the DSS department, Lesley Brooks. She has been a fantastic addition to our staff and has been working hard to get to know many of our open access journal editors and provide them the best service possible, including annual reports for each journal, filled with lots of statistics and other handy information.

We are, as ever, excited to see the possibilities for DSS and the library in the coming year. Though this has been a year of challenges, and next year may be as well, we will face them together. Go Bulls!

Services


DSS provides and develops services to directly support the creation of new collections and partnerships, develop and enhance marketing and outreach, and educate students and faculty on scholarly communications and digital literacy. Consultations are available upon request for assistance in:

- Copyright and Intellectual Property

GIS services provided by DSS were combined with the Digital Heritage and Humanities Collections (DHHC) GIS Lab (<u>https://gis-usflibrary.hub.arcgis.com/</u>) during the fiscal year 2020 to provide an enhanced experience to faculty and student researchers.

Copyright and Intellectual Property

Copyright services received 211 questions during the 2020 fiscal year. This is a 3.2% decrease from FY19. Of the questions, 65 were consultations, a 12% increase from last year, yet the average length of time spent with each question, 20 minutes, was roughly the same as last year. Engineering students and faculty asked the most questions of any department, followed by the libraries, school of humanities, and school of sciences and mathematics.



Question complexity is mostly basic during both FY19 and FY20. However, questions received during 2020 show a slight shift to more moderately complex questions. Similar to previous years, the topic of theses and dissertations (ETD) made up the largest amount of questions at 41% of all

received, followed by questions about using library collections, regarding copyright issues in teaching, and research and publishing activities.

ETD Graduate Survey

A post-service survey was developed in FY2020 to obtain additional feedback from the graduate students asking ETD questions. The data for this fiscal year came from submission cycles in October and April. The survey was sent to 53 individual graduates who had used copyright services and received 28 responses. The first two questions asked the students to rate the success of their interaction with a Likert scale. In response to the question that asked whether the student learned something new that would be helpful to them, 86% strongly agreed, 14% agreed. In response to the question whether they were working towards a master's degree or PhD, 67% of the respondents were working toward their PhD, with 30% working towards their master's degree.

Workshops and Presentations

Four presentations were delivered to various colleges and groups on campus during FY2020. The first was at the request of the College of Pharmacy on 7/26/2019. "Using Media Effectively and Legally in Your Teaching" was jointly developed with Barbara Lewis for the Academy for Teaching and Learning Excellence (ATLE) series, First Fridays, delivered on 9/4/2019. This presentation was reworked into a library sponsored open session via Teams on 4/15/2020. A recording of the session was provided to ATLE for use on its website. Unfortunately, subsequent uses by ATLE may not be trackable.

Similarly, a digital and asynchronous version of the workshop sponsored by the Office of Graduate Studies (OGS) and delivered to ETD graduates in October and February, was shared with OGS at the end of the fiscal year. Previous discussion with OGS indicate their intention to use it in a Canvas course designed for a workshop series. Further tracking may not be available.

Data Management

DSS offers data management assistance for researchers. This includes data management planning and hosting datasets. DSS created the following page to better show the levels of support offered by the library: <u>https://www.lib.usf.edu/scholarly-research-and-communication/data-management-planning/</u>.

A project begun during the 2018/2019FY was completed this year. Dr. Cassandra Smith's volcanic lightning research data is hosted in the USF Digital Collections: <u>https://doi.org/10.5038/volcanic_lightning_home</u>.

Center for Integrated Modeling & Analysis of the Gulf Ecosystem (C-IMAGE)

For a decade, the USF Libraries partnered with the Center for Integrated Modeling and Analysis of Gulf Ecosystems (C-IMAGE) as data managers. Responsible for data management planning, working with researchers on their data management needs, and communicating with representatives of the data managers of the granting agency, the library continues to support C-IMAGE.

The <u>C-IMAGE collection in Scholar Commons</u> contains datasets from USF researchers, publications resulting from C-IMAGE research, and the C-IMAGE podcast *The Loop*. These works come with the same preservation and backup standards as other Scholar Commons material.

Systems & Equipment

Platforms

Scholar Commons is supported by bepress' Digital Commons platform. Find out more information about the Digital Commons platform at <u>http://digitalcommons.bepress.com</u>.

Digital Collections are hosted using the SobekCM platform. SobekCM is an open-source digital collections repository platform, with code hosted as a public project at https://github.com/SobekCM/SobekCM-Web-Application.

DSS Systems Administrator, Richard Bernardy, is a code contributor to Sobek and makes his plugins available as open source downloads at <u>https://github.com/rbernardy</u>. For more information on SobekCM, see <u>http://sobekrepository.org</u>

In the past year, Richard has tested and developed several enhancements to the repository. A rights management feature has been added allowing LeEtta Schmidt, our Copyright and Intellectual Property Librarian, to document the appropriate rights statements at the collection and item levels. This new feature informs our patrons of the copyright status for the digital resources they use in their projects, research, and publications. In order to ensure our digital collections remain secure and sustainable, we are archiving content and metadata packages to the cloud using Amazon Web Services. Finally, a statistics module has been designed to track and record annual patron views, downloads, and collection growth across the Sobek repository.

Upgraded Equipment

Plustek Opti Film 120 Slide Scanner – As an enhancement to this scanner, we have loaded VueScan software, providing our reformatting team improved options such as a preview feature, advance settings options, a faster scanning time, and a more direct, streamlined interface.

Featured Projects

Digitization for the Public Domain



Digital Scholarship Services continued the tradition started in 2019, where we digitized 19 items that had newly fallen into the **public domain**. This year, <u>DSS</u> <u>digitized 20 titles from the Libraries' collections</u>, chosen via vote from the Libraries' faculty and staff. The 20 items enhance four existing, digital collections: Children's Literature, Florida Studies, Science Fiction, and Sheet Music.

Environmental Collections



In 2019, DSS partnered with Special Collections to obtain and plan the digitization of a donation from USF Marine Science professor, **Dr. John Ogden** (<u>https://digital.lib.usf.edu/ogden</u>). The collection will consist of over 30 years of data from Dr. Ogden's research excursions throughout the Caribbean, documenting changes in coral reef ecosystems. The content includes field diaries and notes, illustrations, maps, charts, and photographs of reef, seagrass, and mangrove habitats that support a wide range of marine species.



The Lorida Audubon Collection (<u>https://digital.lib.usf.edu/lorida</u>), containing records from Audubon Florida's station at Lorida, near Sebring, includes environmental reports, documents concerning conflicts with neighbors and violators, internal correspondence, and information on the Kissimmee Prairie Preserve State Park. This collection, including 81 newly digitized items, expands on Audubon records already in Digital Collections.



The Florida Environmental Interface is a centralized online access point for all the USF Libraries' environment and natural history resources. The site is organized by the three parts of the planet's biosphere: the lithosphere, the hydrosphere, and the atmosphere. Twenty collections are featured in the interface, presenting content in a wide range of formats and subjects. Specifically, the Audubon collections consist of over 100 years of valuable


ornithology data represented by wildlife migration studies, slides, field reports, research papers and photographs.



Scholar Commons staff has created **an Environment and Natural History metacollection** (<u>https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/enh_pubs/</u>) in support of the environment and natural history library initiative. Collecting items from Scholar Commons, the metacollection contains over 350 items ranging in topics from karst land use policy to sea-level change. As new areas of emphasis are identified the Scholar Commons staff will create new metacollections.



The Karst Information Portal (www.karstportal.org) is a NCKRI project in partnership with the University of South Florida Libraries (USF), University of New Mexico, and the International Union of Speleology (UIS). . Usage of the Portal continues to increase. Items in the portal have been downloaded 322,195 times this past year. Of those uses, 206,191 uses came from 67 different search engines in 25 countries that have discovered the Portal. KIP usage by human users is coming from 177 of 195 countries in the world, with most of the usage being in the United States, followed by Germany and China. KIP is truly reaching a worldwide audience! The image below shows the top 10 countries of usage for the Karst Information Portal.



USF and Tampa History



The **USF Oracle** (<u>https://digital.lib.usf.edu/oracle</u>), founded in 1966, delivers USF, local, regional, and national news to the USF community and has served as a training ground for student journalists. During its running time, it has captured the spirit and history of the University of South Florida, and received many awards for excellence in journalism. This year DSS added issues from 1972 to the existing Oracle digital collections.



Tampa Bay History Journal (<u>https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/tampabayhistory/</u>)</u> has been published from 2007 to the present as part of the USF Libraries' Open Access Journals. In FY20 the previous run of the journal, from 1979 to 1998, representing the entirety of the journal's publication history, was digitized and added to the current issues. *Tampa Bay History* features the contributions of USF faculty, graduate students, and other scholars of Florida history.



During 2019 and 2020, Digital Scholarship Services continued to work closely with the **Center for Urban Transportation Research** (CUTR - <u>https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/cutr/</u>). In addition to

their two journals hosted in Scholar Commons, we have added a collection of 136 CUTR Research Reports and 64 new NCTR Research Reports.

Digital dialogs



The **Digital Dialogs blog (**<u>https://lib.usf.edu/digital-dialogs/</u>) features posts about digital collections, exhibits, projects, tools, and news. The blog provides a gateway through which students and faculty can discover multimedia and digital humanities projects at USF and at other institutions, as well as

recommending tools and resources that researchers can use in their own multi-media and digital humanities projects. In FY20 the Digital Dialogs team published 23 new posts, doubling the total posts since the blog began in 2018. The ability to record visit statistics was added to the blog in mid-November. From November to the end of FY20, Digital Dialogs had 2,166 views. The most popular posts were those that were shared via the Libraries' social media channels and retweeted or picked up by other USF news channels: <u>Celebrating Black History Month with the USF</u> <u>Photograph Collection</u> and <u>Help Us Celebrate the Public Domain in 2021</u>.

USF Researcher Collections

Research Platform Team collections in Scholar Commons continued to grow from last year's success populating faculty publications for the School of Geosciences, a historically underrepresented area. In FY20, DSS worked with both the Geosciences and History Research Platform Teams to add publications to Scholar Commons.

In 2019–2020, DSS continued to offer the **SelectedWorks Faculty Profiles service** (SelectedWorks profiles) in conjunction with adding their research into Scholar Commons. Currently, there are 289 total SelectedWorks profiles; 60 new profiles were created during FY20. The department affiliations of new SelectedWorks profiles was wide-ranging with 12 departments represented.

The top three are a direct result of outreach activities. The School of Geosciences (53%) and History (11.6%) were a result of the Research Platform Teams. The College of Marine Science (11.6%) occurred as a result of our partnership with the C-IMAGE grant.



The **OA Textbook Collection** (<u>https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/oa textbooks</u>) was Scholar Commons' second most downloaded collection (after ETDs) with 1,028,090 all-time downloads. With 865,454 all-time downloads, our most downloaded textbook was Anol Bhattacherjee's *Social Science Research: Principles, Methods, and Practices.* The second most downloaded textbook was William F. Trench's *Student Solutions Manual for Elementary Differential*

Equations and Elementary Differential Equations with Boundary Value Problems with 130,589 downloads. The third most used textbook, with 20,032 downloads, was Journalism 2.0: How to Survive and Thrive by Mark Briggs.



The **Electronic Theses & Dissertations (ETDs)** in Scholar Commons (<u>https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/etd/</u>) is one of the largest and most heavily used portions of the repository. There are 8,136 ETDs currently in the collection, which have been accessed a total of 8,778,525 times. Rather than having to request a print copy of a dissertation through interlibrary loan, ETDs are discoverable online through the repository. Our ETDs are harvested by the

Networked Digital Library of Theses and Dissertations (NDLTD) and are preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network.



The Open Access Journal Collection

(https://scholarcommons.usf.edu/journals.html) gives researchers across the world 24/7 access to research that would have traditionally been limited by a subscription firewall or few physical print copies. Subject matter is varied, ranging from geology to homeland security to the humanities. We work with Portico to archive Scholar Commons' journal content in their dark archive.

- Twelve are peer-reviewed, keeping to the same quality standards as traditional journals.
- Nine titles are in the Global LOCKSS Network (remaining titles being preserved in the Digital Commons Private LOCKSS Network).
- Three are included in Scopus: Numeracy, International Journal of Speleology and Journal of Strategic Security.
- Two have an impact factor: International Journal of Speleology and Journal of Public Transportation.



In 2019, a new relationship with the **Anchin Center**, affiliated with the College of Education, was started. The Anchin Center was looking for a location to host publications and decided to use Scholar Commons. Jason Boczar met with the Anchin Center staff and helped identify future items to be included and assisted with answering scholarly communication questions.

Digital Collections Activity and Statistics

DSS added 6 new digital collections in FY20, including:

- Dr. John Ogden Florida and Caribbean Reef Collection
- General Video Collection
- Florida Fishing Captains Oral History Project
- City of Tampa Archives
- Lorida Audubon Collection
- Captain Terry L. Howard Photograph Collection

The 6 new collections reflect 162 of the 1,850 new items added to Digital Collections during the year. Overall views to the Digital Collections continued the decline seen in FY19. However, the 5% decrease in views from FY19 to FY20 was much less drastic compared to the 24% drop seen between FY18-FY19. A number of outside factors have impacted marketing efforts for digital collections during FY19-20, including university consolidation and changes to the university environment in response to COVID-19. It is suspected that these factors may have an impact on the use of Digital Collections.


Journal with the most items published 2019/2020


Top Ten Departments by Percentage of Faculty Participation
