### Event Information Forms

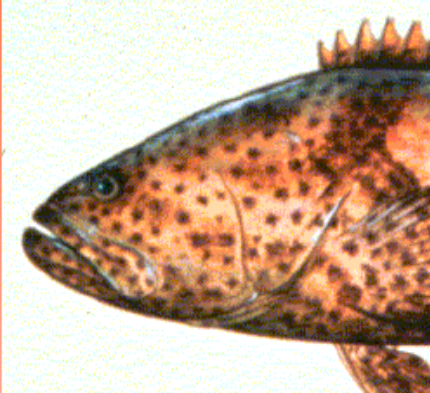
As a reminder, please make sure your organization is filling out an Event Information Form before planning any large events. These forms (and many others are available on the Student Life website and outside CAC 125.
