Tuesday November 2nd from 10am until 2pm. They will be serving donuts for free while supplies last.

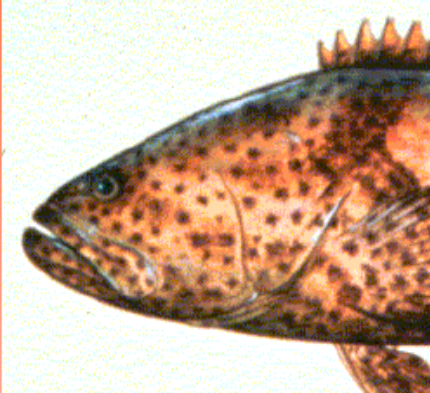
Please stop by the Harborside Walkway and donate for a good cause.
