Notable Accomplishments:

- Secured \$485,000 in funding from student government to renovate the library exterior.

Average textbook cost, per SCH, dropped from \$54 in 2016/17 to \$28 in 2018/19, with the library programs saving students over 1 million dollars during this three-year period.
- Involved in library strategic planning at all stages: from serving as a member of the planning committee, leading 2 strategic goal committees, to documenting and reporting library outcomes.
- Worked to better integrate and streamline workflows between the Access Services, Collection Development & Technical Services, and Research & Instruction departments.
