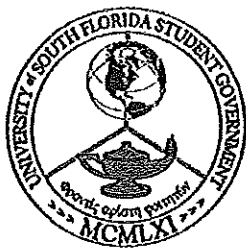

The intent of this bill is to clarify that if a vacancy occurs in the office of Student Body President, the Student Body Vice President automatically and instantaneously assumes the role of Student Body President.

A SENATE STATUTORY AMENDMENT


Be it enacted by the Senate of the University of South Florida Student Government assembled, that the following changes be made to the Student Government Statutes:

Chapter

206


Order of Succession

-
- 206.1 Should a vacancy occur in the Office of the Student Body President, the Student Body Vice-President shall automatically assume the position of Student Body President.
- 206.2 After assuming the role of President, the new Student Body President shall appoint a new Student Body Vice-President, ~~who shall be~~ The appointee must be confirmed by Senate prior to taking office.
- 206.3 If the Office of the Student Body Vice-President is vacant at the time the office of the Student Body President becomes vacant, the following positions are the order of succession in Student Government:
- 206.3.1 Senate President
 - 206.3.2 Senate President Pro Tempore
 - 206.3.3 Attorney General
