Electronic Meeting November, 2014

Action: A GEB 4941 internship was created on an S/U basis as an approved elective for each COB major except Accounting. Also, a USFSP Internship Application Instructions was approved. (This course required and received approval at the 11/21 faculty meeting. It was later approved by the campus Undergraduate Council.) For each of these courses:

- All internships will still require approval from a faculty member in that discipline to count as an approved elective.
- Existing graded (A-F) internship classes will remain in the catalog for disciplines that already have that option.
- Students have to go through an application process and agree to all internship guidelines.

Action: The ACG 4XXX internship was created on an S/U basis as an approved elective for Accounting. (This course did not require a vote of the full faculty. It was approved by the campus Undergraduate Council.)
