Actions: The committee took action on the following proposals.

Add ISM 3431 to the course catalogue. PASSED. (6 for, 0 against)

Reduce required non-business hours from 54 to 48. PASSED. (6 for, 0 against)

Add Principles of Entrepreneurship (ENT 3004) to the business core requirements. DEFEATED. (2 for, 4 against)

Approval of Minutes February 20 Meeting

Deferred until next meeting.

Proposal for ISM 3431 Course: Operations & Supply Chain Processes

Passed unanimously. The course will not count as a management elective unless specifically approved in advance. Kearns will ask Alison Watkins if the course counts towards the MBA operations management requirement.

Proposal for Reducing Non-Business Hours

A proposal to reduce required non-business hours from 54 to 48 was passed unanimously. Kearns explained that he had sent an email to Linda Crossman advising of the proposal and asking if there were any issues, administrative or otherwise, that might impede this action.

Proposal for Adding ENT 3004 to the Business Core Curriculum

A proposal to add the course Principles of Entrepreneurship (ENT 3004) to the business core requirements. The proposal was defeated. (2 in support, 4 against)

Student Deficiencies in Communication

Kearns stated that this should be discussed among faculty.

Other Business

Jackson stated that the COB needed an overall assessment of the business core that would include determining (1) what courses should be in the core, and (2) are the learning objectives for those courses being met.
