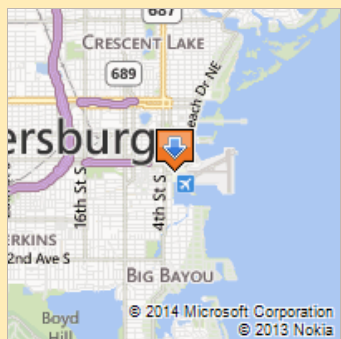

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## Photo Story 3 - Let's create a video-slideshow

Have you ever thought about creating an awesome video using your photos? It's not as hard as you think. Photo Story 3 for Windows (a free video-slideshow creator from Microsoft) helps you create exciting video stories from your pictures that you can share with students, colleagues, family, and friends. For example, you could create a video story that features narrated photographs from a student field trip or a video story that includes pictures and sounds from a campus event.

In just a few simple steps, you will learn how to import and edit your pictures, add titles, record narration, add background music, and save your story using the optimal quality settings for the way your story will be played. Your students can then use any program that plays Windows Media Video (WMV) files, such as Windows Media Player to view your story.
