Governor Leads Town Hall on Campus

On Monday, June 14, Florida Governor Jeb Bush will host a town-hall meeting on campus to discuss innovative and new affordable health care options now available to Florida employers and consumers. The event is from 9 -10 am in the Campus Activities Center. The town-hall meeting is free and open to the public.

The June 14 event is the first in a series of town-hall meetings across the state this summer intended to better educate Floridians on the benefits of Health Savings Accounts and Health Reimbursement Arrangements - innovative new health care products designed improve access to affordable health care while empowering consumers to invest in health care savings.
