 - CAS: Florida Studies Changes to Program - Approved.
 - a. Delete Required Courses: HIS 6930 (History of Modern Florida; Early Florida History); GEA 6195 (Geography of Florida or approved environmental course with Florida content); XXXX Any approved literature, writing or media course with Florida content)
 - b. Add Required Course, AMS 6908, Independent Study as alternative to AMS 6940 Internship, which is retained (i.e. Required: AMS 6940 Internship OR AMS 6908, Independent Study)
 - c. Drop written and oral comprehensive exams and replace with a research proposal defense: All students will produce and defend a written research proposal. The proposal defense will serve as a comprehensive exam.
 - d. Develop enough hybrid/online courses to allow completion of the degree without students moving to St. Petersburg.

CAS: Florida Studies New Course - Approved.

- a. AMS 6xxx (AMS 6020) Florida and Regional Studies; Note: this is a revision to the course title Introduction to Florida and Regional Studies
- b. GEO 6xxx (GEO 6283) Florida Springs; Note: currently offered Summer only; to develop online content and move to hybrid course
- c. HIS 5xxx (HIS 5062) Spanish Paleography I; Note: open to both grad and undergrad students; an elective described as "an informal requirement for most students interested in early Florida history." Currently offered 1x year since 2012
- d. HIS 5xxx (HIS 5063) Spanish Paleography II; Note: open to both grad and undergrad students; an elective described as "an informal requirement for most graduate students interested in early Florida history." Currently offered 1x year since 2013

COB: MBA Business Analytics concentration; Note: No proposal forms from the online proposal system - Approved as amended.

Fundamentals of Data Management and Analysis; ISM 6930, IT Project Management;
ISM 6930 Predictive Analytics

- b. Six Core MBA courses
- c. Two elective courses

COB: Graduate Certificate Business Analytics - Approved as amended.
