Activity

Sept-October (via e-mail) Revised Internal Research and Creative Scholarship (IR/CS) application form to ameliorate invalid applications.

December 7, 2017 Meeting (Chair: Chris Davis)

- Discussed and ranked the nominations for the Chancellor's Award for Research and Creative Scholarship. Three applications were ranked and the results sent to the Office of Academic Affairs.
- Set work plan for FY;
- Finalized internal grant call;

December-January (via e-mail etc) Reviewed Internal Research and Creative Scholarship (IC/RS) applications.

January 18, 2018 Meeting (Chair: Mark Pezzo)

- IC/RS final review and adjudication; 12 applications qualified for review with 1 additional application for a mentoring grant. The following recommendations were made to the Office of Academic Affairs: 10 applications recommended for full funding, 2 applications were not recommended for funding. Constructive feedback for future consideration was sent to applicants who did not receive funding.
- Developed scoring rubric for internal grants.
