Update on furniture and equipment. In order to bring the furniture and equipment back to budget, C. Kreher suggested we use Worden's lowest level of furniture, which is designed for K-12 use; we had asked for the level above that. Lanny has talked to the Dean and he would like us to have quality/sturdy furniture in the new building. The furniture and equipment "exercise" is still a "moving target" - next meeting is scheduled for Friday, January 26.

Building is moving along at a pretty good pace. A group of SAPL folks will be touring the building at 4:30, Friday, January 26th. Librarians are welcome to join the tour if they desire.

We are still planning on April for the move; the bid for moving has not yet gone out.

Karilyn asked if New College students who are jointly attending USF should have a USF ID and can they use Lexis/Nexis if they do not have a USF degree? Concensus at this point seems to be if they want to use Lexis/Nexis, they must have a USF ID or they must be valid according to the NOTIS/USF database.

Some discussions followed about what types of CDROMs we might want to provide in the future (particularly the non-bibliographic citation databases) and what kinds of equipment might be required:

- would we need multi-media stations?
- should they be networked or stand-alone?
- what about security issues?

It was suggested that we discuss the CDROM issue at the next librarian meeting.
