**Doc Martin: The Movie** When successful but unhappy Dr. Martin Bamford discovers that his wife has been sleeping with three of his friends, his world is ripped apart. Doc flees London and heads for the small fishing village of Port Isaac, on the north coast of Cornwall, to work out the big questions in his life. Airs Tuesday, July 3, 9 p.m.

**Doc Martin and the Legend of the Cloutie** The doc decides he needs distance from Port Isaac and falls in love with a ramshackle, middle-of-nowhere property called Tregrunn Farm. But another family has its eye on the same property so Doc decides to scare them off with the help of the legendary Beast of Bodmin. **William and Mary** Martin Clunes stars as William and Julie Graham as Mary in this romantic comedy series about two single parents looking for love. But it's not going to be easy when one is an undertaker and the other a midwife—to say nothing about Mary's mother, Molly, who stands in their way. Premieres Tuesday, July 17, 9 p.m.





**Queen Elizabeth II: A Diamond Jubilee Celebration** is a comprehensive retrospective showing the reign of Elizabeth II at key points in her life.
