Sir:

Reference is made to previous correspondence concerning the repatriation of Mrs. Josefa Oural and to your letter of October 22, 1936, with which you deposited a check in the amount of \$100 for payment to Mrs. Oural at Vigo, Spain.

A telegram was received from the American Consul at Vigo reporting that the amount of \$10 was paid to Mrs. Oural at Vigo. The balance of \$90 was forwarded to the American Consul General at Lisbon, Portugal, for payment upon Mrs. Oural's arrival there enroute to the United States.

The Department has received a despatch from the American Consul General at Lisbon, transmitting his account covering payment of the sum of \$90 to Mrs. Josefa Oural. A copy of the account is enclosed.
