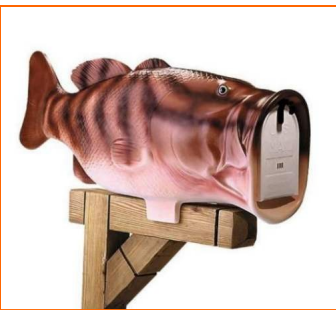

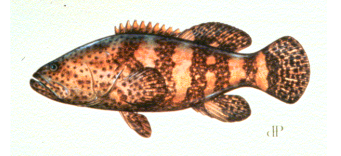

This newsletter will serve as a reminder about important upcoming events and deadlines for your organization. As a reminder, the deadline to re-register your organization is coming soon.


2010-2011 Re-Registration Process:

1. Log in to BlackBoard (my.usf.edu)

2. Click the "myUSF" tab. Under the "myUSF" tab, click the "Student Life" link on the toolbar.
3. On the right side of the screen look for the wording "Presidents Update and Manage Your Organizations". Click the "Search" button next to this line of text.
4. Search for your Student Organization.
5. Click the "Membership" icon on the far right side of the screen. 
6. Update your organization's membership, including adding all new members, removing former members, and updating roles of any current members.
7. Verify your advisor's



information is correct.

8. Return to the Search page and again search for your organization. (Steps 1-4 above).
9. Click the "Details" icon on the far right side of the screen. 
10. Make changes to your profile by typing in the new information and click "Submit changes"
11. Scroll to the bottom of the screen and look for the button that says "Re-Register This Organization".
12. Click this button.
13. Your organization has now re-registered for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Student Organization Training Sessions

In order to assist our student organizations and to educate all organizations on the current student organization handbook, all organizations are required to send at least one representative to **MANDATORY** student organization training sessions. These training sessions will be held over several weeks to allow maximum opportunities for at least one representative to attend. These sessions will cover all USFSP policies, all policies of the Department of Student Life and Engagement, and will be an opportunity to

learn more about receiving Student Government funding for your organization. If your organization does not send at least one representative to one of these meetings, your organization may be made inactive for the remainder of the semester.

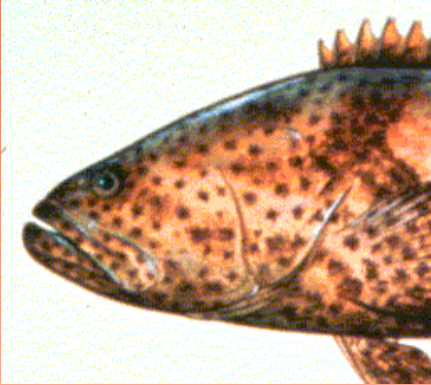
