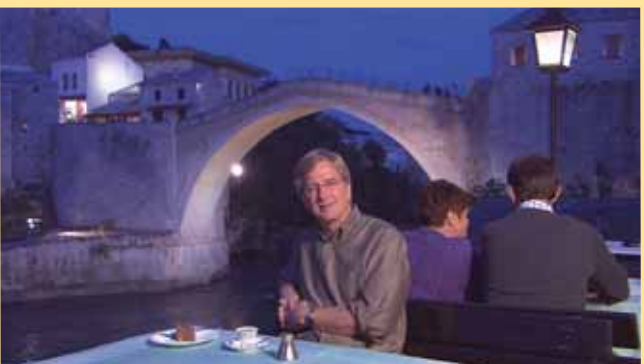
call the midwife
