**Special Issue – Pay Increase**

USF is implementing a 3 year plan for salary increases.

Pay increase will be based on point system per division. 40% will be from market value and 60% from performance. Only the best will be recommended for the increase.

Deadline for submission by deans/directors is July 31<sup>st</sup>.

We have our own funds separate from Tampa for our increases. Karen White will have final say over how these funds will be distributed.

Once plans are finalized, David will invite Sandy Levins to speak to both USPS and A&P groups.

Approximately 50% will receive an increase and 50% will not.
