DECISION RENDERED: 8/5/2014

Question before the Court:

1. "Does Statute 405.3 include committees? And Special Sessions of the Senate?"

Decision:

- I. § 405.3 states, "The Senate shall not meet during the first week of Summer Semester A or last week of each summer semester." It is the opinion of the Panel that this includes Committee meetings and Special Sessions of the Senate.
