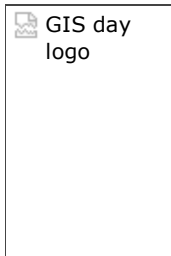
 **USFSP'S OWN STATE REPRESENTATIVE CHARLIE JUSTICE VISITS GOVERNMENT CLASS**
