## **Introduction to the Collection**

The Retired Executives Advisory Panel (REAP) Sun Coast Papers were donated to the Nelson Poynter Memorial Library to serve as a record of that organization's activities during its first two decades. Materials in this collection contain no access restrictions.

### **Institutional Note**

Formed in 1977 and incorporated in 1978, the Retired Executives Advisory Panel (REAP) provided civic leadership on important issues faced by residents of Pinellas County. Members—who joined by invitation only—included retired business executives who sought to “advance the economic, cultural, social, and civic resources of the community.” Monthly meetings included roundtable discussions, project overviews, and guest speakers familiar with issues facing the residents of Pinellas County.

### **Preservation Note**

The materials in this collection occupy four acid-free document boxes. While preservation measures may slow the physical deterioration of such items, these steps cannot prevent damage from occurring. To prevent further damage to the fragile materials in this collection, avoid exposing them to light for an extended period of time. ### **Scope and Contents**

The contents occupy four document boxes (approximately two linear feet). Inclusive dates cover the late 1970s to 2000, with the bulk of the material covering the period from 1979 through 1995. Items fall within four distinct series: Organizational Records, Position Papers, Administrative Records, and Subject Files.
