Introduction to the Collection

The photographs and slides in this collection document campus activities and student life at the University of South Florida St. Petersburg. J. M. “Sudsy” Tschiderer donated three scrapbooks in summer 2005 to the Nelson Poynter Memorial Library for use in the Fortieth Anniversary Exhibit of the campus. She gave the library additional slides, photographs, and photographic negatives in August 2006. These images illustrate the period from the mid-1960s through 1989 and capture notable events, members of the campus community, and general scenes that document the university experience at USF St. Petersburg.

Preservation Note/Format Note

The materials in this collection occupy three scrapbooks, two standard boxes, and one oversize box. While preservation measures may slow the physical deterioration of items, these steps cannot prevent damage from occurring. To prevent further damage to the fragile materials in this collection, avoid exposing them to light for an extended period of time. Please report any tears or other damage so that library staff may take appropriate preservation or conservation measures. Special Collections staff has already digitized some photographs from this collection for use in exhibits. Provenance of the Tschiderer Student Activities Archives (Photographs)

The photographs in this collection, created by J. M. “Sudsy” Tschiderer and others associated with the Division of Student Affairs, fall under Record Group 730 (Student Affairs: Activities and Organizations) of the USF St. Petersburg Archives, Special Collections and Archives department, Nelson Poynter Memorial Library. Some photographs in Scrapbook 3 were also taken by Gerald Notaro, Media Librarian, Poynter Library.

Scope and Contents

These items occupy 2.10 linear feet and offer a portrait of the people, activities, and events associated with the University of South Florida St. Petersburg. Coverage began in the late 1960s, at a time when the campus covered the peninsula presently used by the College of Marine Science. Many photographs show student events and activities at the campus pool, in “A” and “B” Buildings, and along Bayboro Harbor. Photographs from the 1980s document the expansion of campus facilities with the opening of the original Poynter Library (now Bayboro Hall), Davis Hall (formerly Bayboro Hall), and Coquina Hall.
