




Be sure to catch the new animated children's series Peg + Cat Monday through Friday at 7:30 p.m.!

### JFK in Tampa: The 50th Anniversary

JFK in Tampa: The 50th Anniversary combines rare footage of President Kennedy's visit to Tampa on November 18, 1963 just four days before his assassination. This one-hour documentary, featuring unique photos and first-hand accounts, takes us back to a simpler time when the average income was \$5,800, a loaf of bread was 22 cents and the most popular TV show was The Beverly Hillbillies. This was the first time a sitting president came to Tampa and tens of thousands of people turned out along the 28-mile presidential motorcade route to greet him — in the same open convertible used in Dallas just four days later. JFK in Tampa: The 50th Anniversary is a very special video time capsule about a city's special day in the sun. You'll hear from dignitaries who rode and shared the stage with JFK, along with journalists and others who came to witness this magical and memorable visit.
