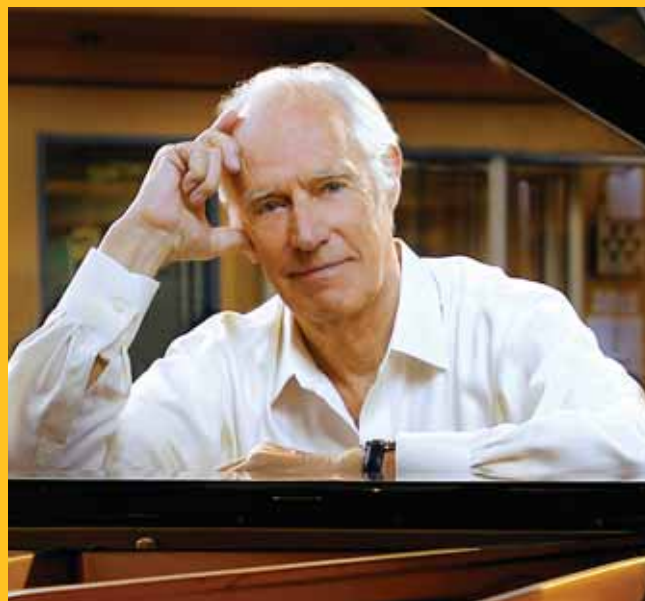

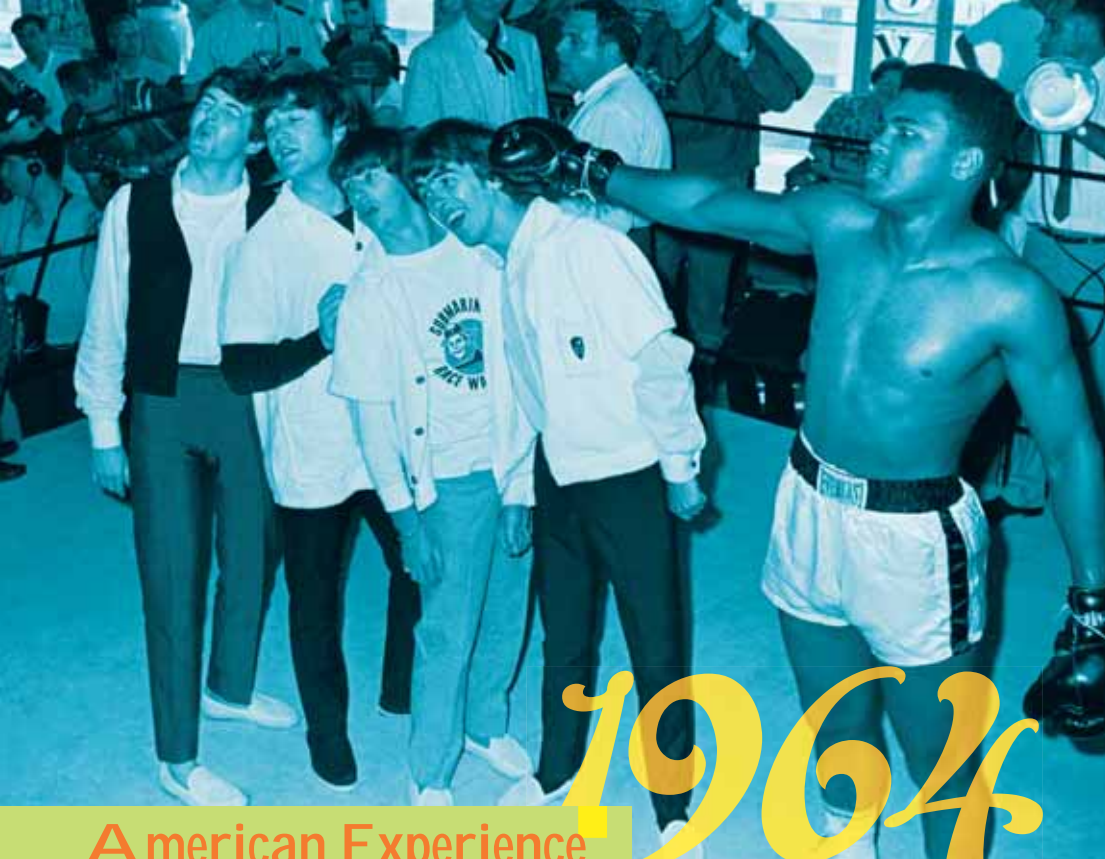


New season of *Doc Martin* coming in February!

1964

It was the year of the Beatles and the Civil Rights Act; of the Gulf of Tonkin and Barry Goldwater's campaign for the presidency; the year that Americans learned smoking was bad for their health and Cassius Clay became Muhammad Ali; the year that cities across the country erupted in violence and Americans tried to make sense of the assassination of their president. Based on *The Last Innocent Year: America in 1964* by award-winning journalist Jon Margolis, this film follows some of the most prominent figures of the time, including Lyndon B. Johnson, Martin Luther King, Jr., Barry Goldwater, and Betty Friedan, and brings out from the shadows the actions of ordinary Americans whose frustrations, ambitions, and anxieties began to turn the country onto a different course.
