## Introduction to the Collection

The *Clearwater Sun* newspaper was published between 1914 and 1990. Few original issues prior to the 1970s exist, and issues from the earliest years (pre-1926) do not exist in microfilm. The *St. Petersburg Evening Independent* served as the Sunshine City's afternoon newspaper between 1906 and 1986. Similar to the *Sun*, early issues rarely exist. This collection represents a small sample of original issues of the *Clearwater Sun* and the *Evening Independent* from the end of the Second World War and the beginning of the Korean War. The Poynter Library received these papers as a donation from the Tampa Bay History Center on 24 January 2008.

## Preservation Note

Newspapers in this collection reside in an acid-free container along with other notable historic newspapers. While preservation measures may slow the physical deterioration of such items, these steps cannot prevent damage from occurring. To prevent further damage to the fragile materials in this collection, avoid exposing them to light for an extended period of time.
