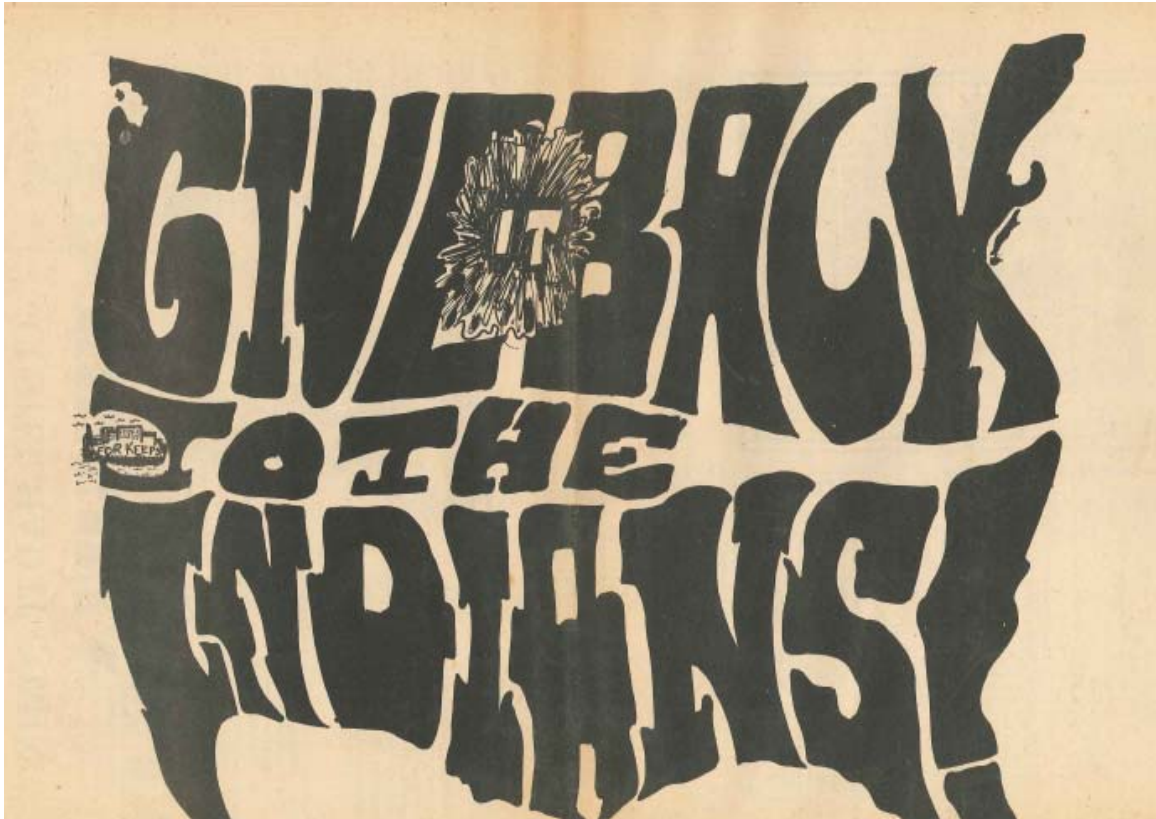

Introduction to the Collection

This collection includes a variety of underground newspapers, various pamphlets and flyers, and various documents related to political activities, social justice, American involvement in the Vietnamese conflict, and other events during the late 1960s and early 1970s. Collected by William "Bill" Hamilton, a 1995 graduate of the University of South Florida, these materials illustrate the topics of discussion from that time and how the alternative and underground press characterized the rapidly changing social landscape. Most of the underground papers and miscellaneous documents originated from the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area. Mr. Hamilton donated these papers to the Nelson Poynter Memorial Library in August 2013 due to their historical value to students of history, journalism, and other liberal arts disciplines.

Scope and Contents

The contents are comprised of 1.4 linear feet of newspapers, fliers, and pamphlets.

Related Collections

The Poynter Library has other manuscript collections that document the importance of underground and alternative newspapers. The USF St. Petersburg Underground Newspaper Collection (<http://hdl.handle.net/10806/1593>), received in the fall of 1992, includes more than 2,700 individual newspapers that cover a variety of geographic regions throughout the United States, primarily from the late 1960s through the mid-1970s. A collection of local provenance, the *ComeUnity* newspaper, resides in the Ray and Margo Yazell Collection. Some of the events addressed in this collection discuss the Presidential Administration of Richard M. Nixon. Researchers interested in the immediate journalistic coverage of President Nixon's resignation may also wish to consult the Nixon Resignation Newspaper Collection at the Poynter Library (<http://hdl.handle.net/10806/1631>).
