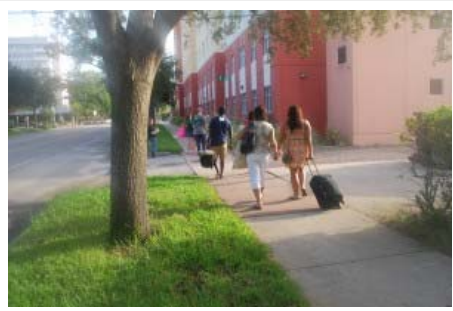
A summer rite of passage for incoming students

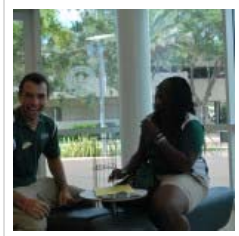
