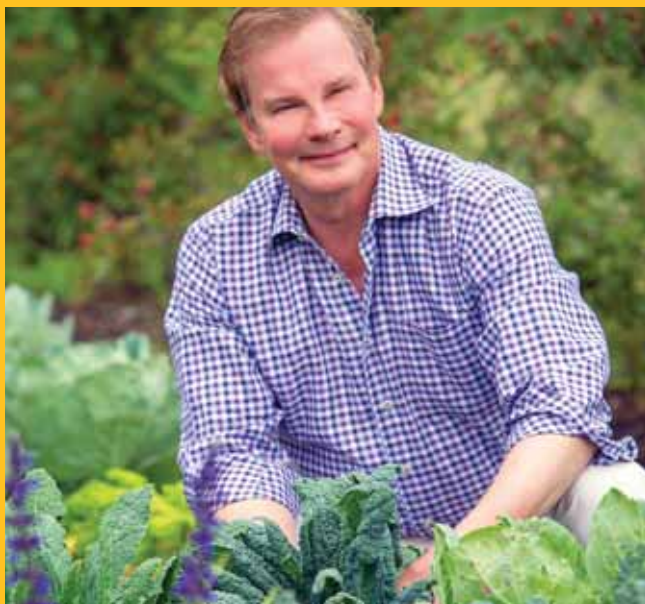
## wusftv Midsomer Murders
