The Bookstore will reopen at 9 AM on Monday, July 3.

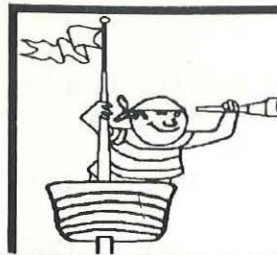
