years; and that it is my bona fide intention to become a citizen of the  
United States of America, and to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any and  
every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the  
Queen of Spain of whom I am now a subject.
