TOBACCO AND OTHER CROPS IN VIRGINIA.—A correspondence dating from Culpepper, Va., writes: "Prof. Maury's theory on the subject of temperature rendered mild by the approach of the Gulf stream to the coast has at least the endorsement of the fall and winter thus far, and, but for an occasional northern blast rattling hail against our windows and crusting our sidewalk with sleet, we might believe of a verity that the brood of old Boreas would hereafter melt into April showers as it touched the Atlantic slope. Let it not be believed that sleet or hail can cool the warmth of our faith in the science of Prof. Maury, for if ocean tide has yet concealed from his searching investigation any of the secrets of its ebb and flow, it must be in its secret caverns, and it must be one of those gems of science of a purer ray serene whose lustre the jealousy of science intends to conceal from mortal view. He has certainly "dragged up drowned horrors by the locks," and being willing to regard him as orthodox, permit me to base a theory and start investigation on a subject that ought to be of paramount interest to landowners in this section of the State. I need not be more minute (for the purposes of this article in the topography of the Piedmont section of the State of Virginia, than to call the attention of your readers to the fact that, at or near Gordonsville, there is a dividing ridge or backbone separating the waters of the James from the waters of the Rappahannock; that the waters flowing to the James traverse the tobacco and grain country, and the waters flowing to the Rappahannock traverse a grass and grain country. Please notice my italics, and time will be saved me in making an argument to show the compensating favor of Providence, and, at the same time, suggest the point of my argument. In the former country grain is really the auxiliary of tobacco, which is the staple, and its grain-bearing capacity is only equal to the surplus that the tobacco culture demands. Tobacco raises and recognizes this fact, and their main attention has been
