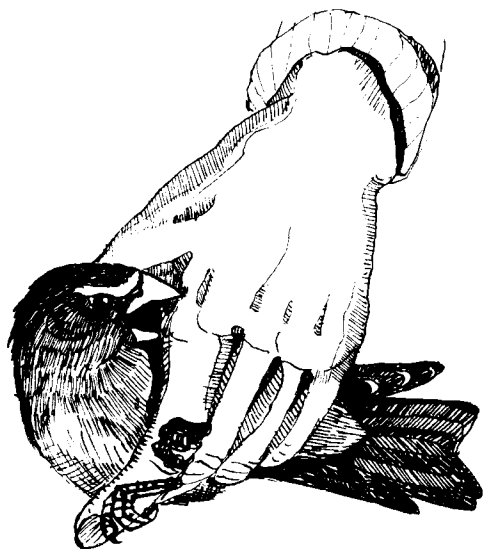

# The 1977-78 invasion of grosbeaks and siskins

At the time, I felt that the winter of 1976-77 had a real invasion of Evening Grosbeaks, when I banded 1,192. However, the winter season of 1977-78 far exceeded that figure, with 2,895 Evening Grosbeaks and also 2,680 Pine Siskins — a grand total of 5,575 birds of these two species banded.

The Evening Grosbeaks were the first to arrive, on 12 November 1977, and the first Pine Siskins on 8 December 1977 — approximately a month ahead of schedule. The last Evening Grosbeak was banded on 16 May 1978; while 18 May 1978 was the last day for the siskins.

Some of the best banding days for the grosbeaks were 19 December (108); 7 January (113); 19 April (74); and 5 May (62). For Pine Siskins: 22 December (177); 29 December (117); 27 April (91); 7 May (78); and 17 May (53).

There were 30 foreign Evening Grosbeaks and 3 Pine Siskins trapped. (One foreign House Finch was also captured.)

**Evening Grosbeaks banded by month:** November, 473; December, 761; January, 765; February, 356; March, 145; April, 220; May 175; total 2,895.

**Evening Grosbeak sex data:** 1,455 males; 1,440 females.

**Pine Siskins banded by month:** December, 917; January, 499; February, 93; March, 156; April, 630; May, 385; total 2,680.

**Pine Siskin sex data:** 15 males; 189 females; 2,476 unknown. ☉
