

# UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

## STATE OF FLORIDA, COUNTY OF HILLSBOROUGH.

Be it Remembered, That on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, A.D. 1902,  
Manuel G. Castro late of Spain, at present of  
Hillsborough, County, Florida, appeared in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and  
applied to said Court to be admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America; and it appearing to  
the Court by the testimony of Joseph R. Jarvis and Emilio Garcia  
of Hillsborough County, Florida, that said applicant has resided in the United States during the last five  
years, and for the year last past has resided within the State of Florida; and it further appearing that  
he made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States according to the statutes more  
than two years since, and that he is over twenty-one years of age, and is in all other respects entitled to be-  
come a naturalized citizen: It is therefore ordered that the said Manuel G. Castro  
be allowed to take the oath of allegiance to the United States and become a citizen thereof.

Whereupon the said Manuel G. Castro takes the oath of allegiance required  
by law and is admitted and adjudged to be a naturalized citizen of the United States of America.
