BE IT REMEMBERED That on the 22nd day of May A. D. 1906,
Peter M. Curad, late of Turkey, at pres-

ent of Hillsborough County, State of Florida, appeared in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, in and for the county of Hillsborough, and applied to said court to become a naturalized citizen of the United States of America; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the court by the oath of the said applicant and from the testimony of C. S. Chas. M. and E. W. Moursa

of Hillsborough County, Florida, that said applicant has resided in the United States during the last five years, and for the year last past in the State of Florida; that he is a native of the Empire of Turkey and a subject of the Sultan of said country; that he made a declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States according to the statutes in such case made and provided ~~more than two years since~~ that he came to the United States while under age of 18 yrs; that he is more than twenty-one years of age, and is in all other respects entitled to become a naturalized citizen of the United States.

And it further appearing to the satisfaction of the court from the testimony above mentioned, that the said applicant does not disbelieve in, nor is he opposed to, all organized government; that he is not a member of, nor affiliated with, any organization entertaining and teaching such disbelief in, or opposition to, all organized governments; that he does not advocate nor teach the duty, necessity or propriety of the unlawful assaulting or killing of any officer or officers, either of specific individuals or of officers generally, of the government of the United States, nor of any other organized government, because of his or their official character; and that he, the said applicant, has not violated any of the provisions of Chapter 1012 of the laws of the 2nd session of the Congress of the United States, being an Act approved March 3d, 1903; and the affidavits of the said applicant and of his witnesses setting forth the above recited facts having been duly entered of record in this court, upon this his final application for naturalization.

IT IS THEREFORE upon consideration of the premises, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the said Peter M. Curad be allowed to take the oath of allegiance to the United States of America and become a citizen thereof.

Whereupon the said Peter M. Curad takes the oath of allegiance required by law and is admitted and adjudged to be a naturalized citizen of the United States of America.
