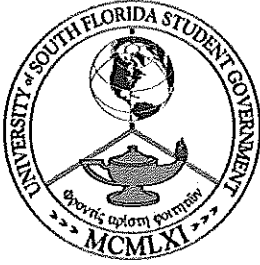

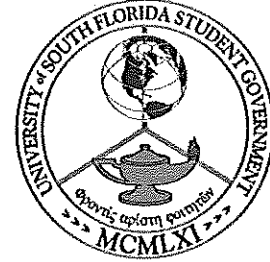

Edit to Grievance Submission Procedure

52nd Term

Fall 2011

The intent of this bill is to refine the grievance submission process so grievances are turned in only to the Senate President, who signs them, ensures they are time stamped, and submits them to the Judiciary and Ethics Committee.

A SENATE STATUTORY AMENDMENT

Be it enacted by the Senate of the University of South Florida Student Government assembled, that the following changes be made to the Student Government Statutes:

Chapter

210

Student Government Investigations¹

210.1 Any Student may call for an investigation of Student Government Members, A&S funded Organizations, Programs, Services, or Student Government related entities.

210.2 Investigational Procedure

210.2.1 In order for the investigation to be valid the issuer must submit the Student Government Grievance Form (As found in the end of this chapter) to the Student Senate President ~~and the Student Government Advisor and the Student Government Advising and Training Operations Bureau Director or Assistant Director.~~


210.2.1.1. Grievances must include the date of the events referenced in the grievance.


- 210.2.2 After ~~the Grievance Form has been time-stamped and signed by- the Senate President~~
~~confirmed receipt of the form via signature~~, the Committee on Judiciary and Ethics will evaluate whether the matter requires investigation.
- 210.2.3 Should the Committee determine the matter worthy, a thorough investigation will be conducted in accordance with the Committee's Standard Operating Procedures.
- 210.2.4 The Committee will recommend the best course of action to be undertaken by the Senate.
- 210.3 The Committee's recommendation may include courses of action such as Censure, Impeachment, Judicial Review, or Freezing of an Organizations Account.

It will be the duty of the Senate to take up any recommendation the Committee may make
