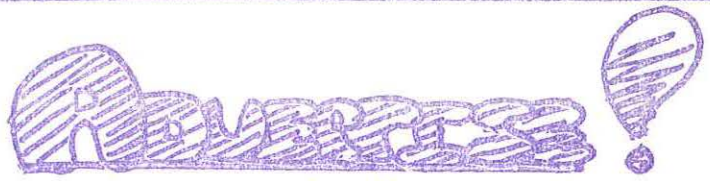
What is the ship which has been anchored near the side parking lot?

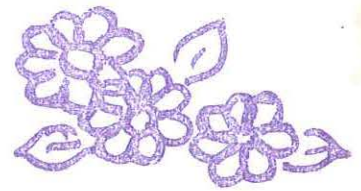
