The drive is not yet over and Chairman Jobson urges everyone to be ready with their "hearts and pocketbooks open." whether you have a boy in the service or not, you will want to give generously to the Red Cross. At a Red Cross rally in the City Auditorium last Tuesday, I had the privilege of hear Eddie Rickenbacker discuss the wonderful job the Red Cross is doing on the fronts as he did it when he made his tour of the battle-fronts. He pointed out that has taken us 7,000 men in casualties to take only half of the 8 square mile island of Iwo. You can imagine how costly it will be to take the Jap main islands. Rickenbacker also pointed out that there would be a 10 to 15 year war with the Japs in the Pacific and in China before we defeat them entirely. Speaking as a man who has spent 28 days on a raft without food or water, he says that there isn't enough that we can do to help the Red Cross in the wonderful work it is doing. As you know the Germans aren't feeding American prisoners as required by the Geneva Confention. It is the Red Cross who sees that food is sent through to our boys in prison camps. Give all you can to the Red Cross.
