in the county and State aforesaid, appeared in the Circuit Court of the Sixth Judicial Circuit  
of Florida, (the said Court having a common law jurisdiction, and a Clerk and Seal, and  
being a Court of Record), and applied to the said Court to be admitted to become a citizen of  
the United States of America, pursuant to the directions and acquisitions of the several acts  
of Congress in relation thereto; and the said Manuel Hernandez having  
produced to the Court such declarations and renunciations, and taken such Oaths as are by  
such acts required;

THEREUPON it is ordered that the said Manuel Hernandez  
be admitted, and he is accordingly admitted by said Court to be a citizen of the United States  
of America.
